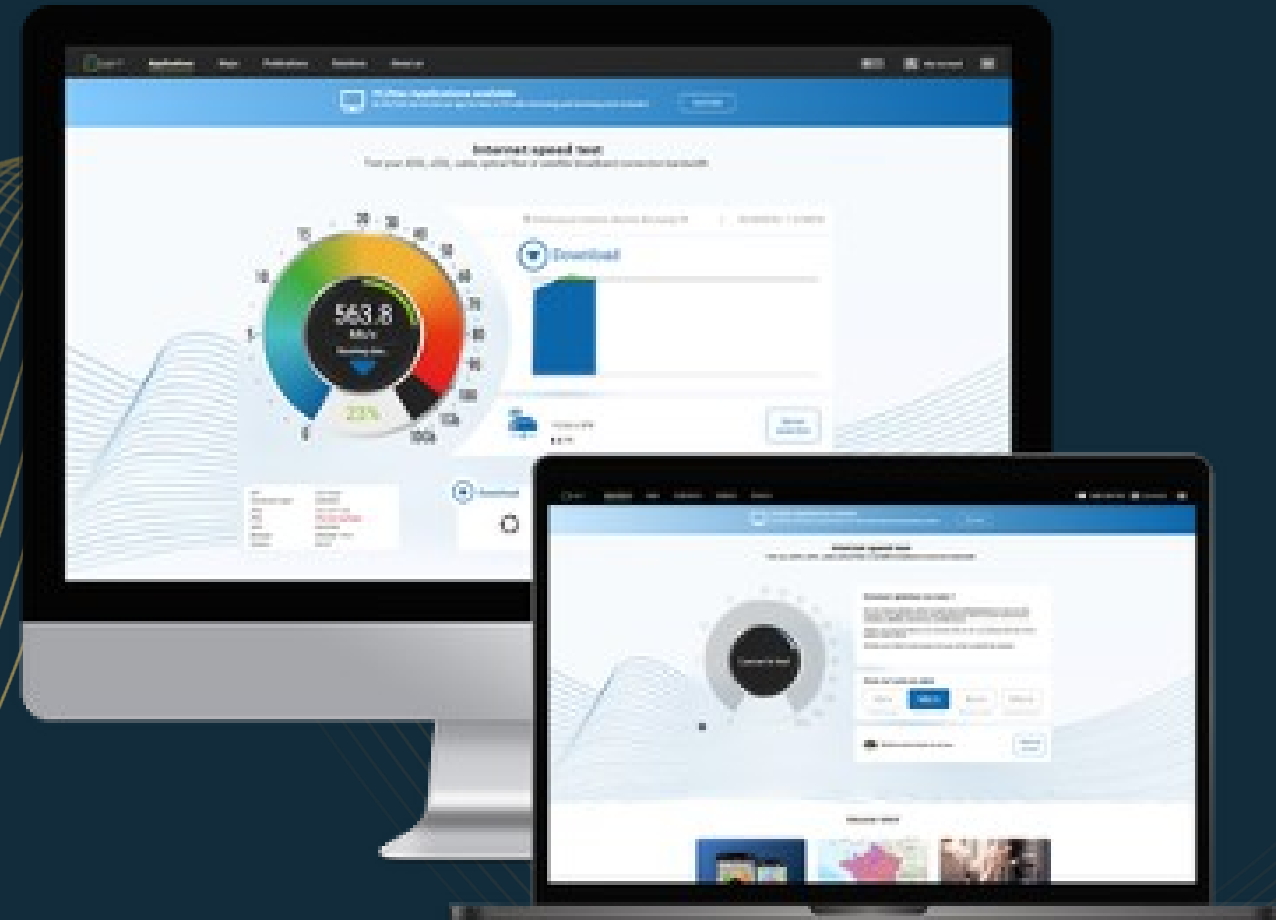

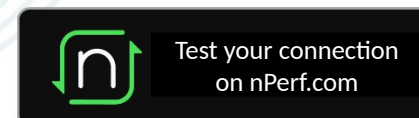

3. Analysis



The best fixed-line Internet performances in Honduras for the 2025–2026 period reveal a competitive landscape where Cable Color, MultiCable, Claro, and Tigo continue to push the boundaries of fixed broadband quality. nPerf's latest barometer highlights meaningful progress across the board, with standout gains in download and upload speeds, while the gap between leaders and challengers continues to evolve in notable ways.

Cable Color: Undisputed Leader for the Second Consecutive Year

Cable Color once again claims the top position in nPerf's overall fixed-line ranking in Honduras, extending a streak of dominance that speaks to consistent network investment and reliability. This is the operator's second consecutive year as overall leader, with category wins in Download speed (Mb/s) — now for the third year running — Upload speed (Mb/s), also for the third consecutive year, as well as Web Browsing (%) and Youtube streaming (%), both held for five uninterrupted years. The numbers back this up convincingly: Download speed (Mb/s) reaches 145.97 Mb/s overall (up from 87.95 Mb/s), while Upload speed (Mb/s) surges to 130.03 Mb/s — a remarkable +92% year-over-year improvement. On FTTH specifically, Cable Color achieves 279.55 Mb/s download and 277.78 Mb/s upload, confirming the depth of its fiber infrastructure. nPerf also notes a steady five-year upward trajectory in Cable Color's overall score, rising from 104,786 to 119,675 points this year.

MultiCable: Fastest Response, Fastest Growth

MultiCable holds second place overall with a score of 95,523 points, up from 90,475 the previous year — continuing a five-year trend of uninterrupted score progression that nPerf has tracked across its barometers. The operator's most distinctive achievement remains its dominance in Latency (ms), ranking first overall for the fourth consecutive year, with a latency of 17.37 ms this year. MultiCable also records a strong +39% increase in overall Download speed (Mb/s), climbing from 36.79 Mb/s to 51.00 Mb/s. On FTTH, Upload speed (Mb/s) reaches an impressive 229.72 Mb/s, ranking third in that segment — a sign of maturing fiber capacity.

Claro: Closing the Gap with Speed Gains

Claro ranks third overall this year with a score of 69,935 points, a modest dip from 72,626 in the previous period, yet the operator's underlying performance tells a more positive story. Most notably, overall Download speed (Mb/s) jumps from 57.60 Mb/s to 79.62 Mb/s — a +38% year-over-year improvement that nPerf identifies as one of the most significant speed gains on the sector. On FTTH, Claro reaches 239.95 Mb/s in Download speed (Mb/s) and 253.19 Mb/s in Upload speed (Mb/s), ranking second in both categories within that technology segment. A five-year trend of consistent overall score growth further underlines the operator's long-term strategic direction.

Tigo: Upload Progress in a Challenging Year

Tigo closes the overall ranking in fourth position with a score of 54,023 points, compared to 59,231 in the previous year, representing the only operator to record a score decline. That said, nPerf highlights a meaningful +19% improvement in overall Upload speed (Mb/s), rising from 8.89 Mb/s to 10.59 Mb/s. On FTTH, Tigo's Download speed (Mb/s) reaches 231.94 Mb/s, ranking third in that segment. The five-year overall score trend for Tigo nonetheless remains positive, suggesting that current-year results reflect a temporary plateau rather than a structural regression.

What's at Stake for 2026–2027

The Honduran fixed-line sector is entering a phase of sharper competition, where incremental gains will increasingly determine rankings. Cable Color must sustain its upload and download leadership while protecting its long-standing advantages in Web Browsing (%) and Youtube streaming (%) — categories where rivals are visibly narrowing the gap on FTTH. MultiCable has the clearest path to disrupting the top spot: converting its latency leadership and growing fiber speeds into broader score improvements, particularly in streaming and browsing, will be key. Claro needs to address its persistent latency challenge — currently the highest on the sector at 76.38 ms overall — while capitalizing on its impressive download momentum to reclaim third-place stability. Tigo, meanwhile, must urgently address the gap in Upload speed (Mb/s), which remains the lowest overall, and work to reverse its score decline before it widens further in a sector where all competitors are accelerating.

4. Methodology



nPerf provides a free application to assess Internet connection quality via its website and mobile apps (Android, iOS). Daily, thousands of people rely on nPerf for speed tests in their country, contributing to a comprehensive crowdsourced database covering all operators.

The study employs a strong filtering method to reflect real customer experiences on a specific network (mobile or fixed line). Measures are taken to prevent probes and measurement robots from affecting the results.

We assess:

▼ Download bitrate

Indicates the amount of data your connection can receive in one second from the nPerf server. The highest the measured value, the best is the bitrate of your connection.

▲ Upload bitrate

Indicates the amount of data your connection can send in one second to the nPerf server. The highest the measured value, the best is the bitrate of your connection.

◄► Latency (ping)

It indicated the delay a small packet of data requires to make a round-trip from your computer to the nPerf server. The shorter the delay, the most reactive your connection is. The mean is the minimum value.

🌐 Browsing performance

The browsing test assesses the load time of the fully loaded pages, including images, javascript, CSS, and fonts, for the five most popular sites. This indicator reflects the perceived quality by the user.

📺 Streaming performance

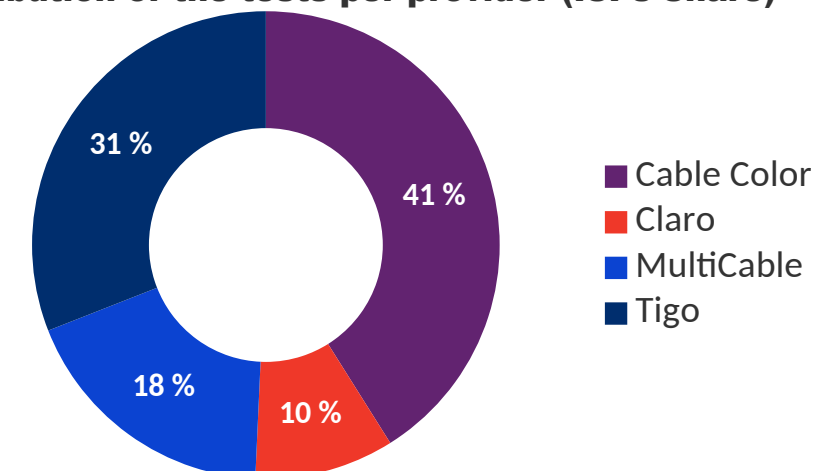
The video streaming test gauges the load time of a fully loaded video in three resolutions on YouTube, considering stalls during playback. This indicator reflects the perceived quality by the user.

Statistical precision is crucial in accurately determining winners. At nPerf, we prioritize test quality, precise reporting, and transparency. Analyzing a large volume of tests in this study, we've achieved 1.5% precision for absolute values and 1% point for percentage-based results, highlighting the reliability and accuracy of our data.

For a more comprehensive understanding of the user experience, our report takes into account test results during both Busy Hours (6 PM to 11 PM) and Idle Hours (the rest of the day). Busy Hours, marked by network strain, can impact user experience through congestion. This approach helps in understanding how network performance fluctuates throughout the day.

We only include national Internet service providers with test share above 5% share. The chart below shows the overall test distribution for each service provider.

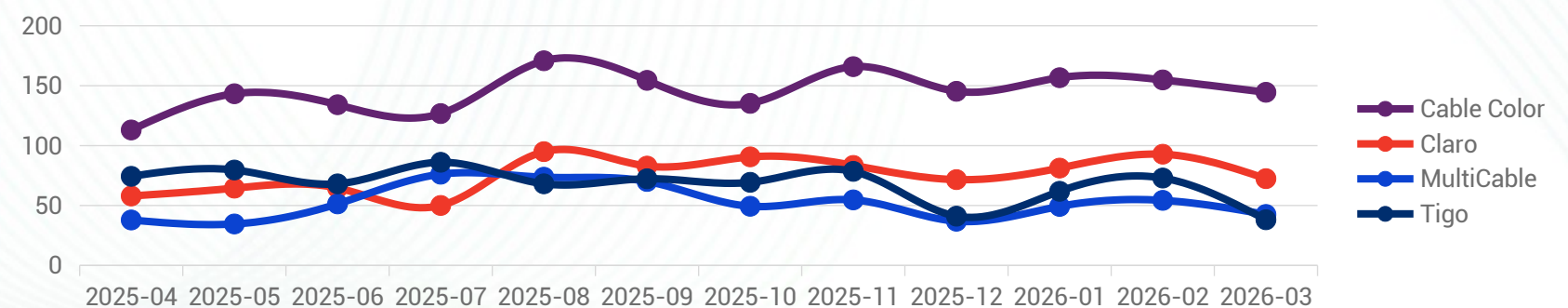

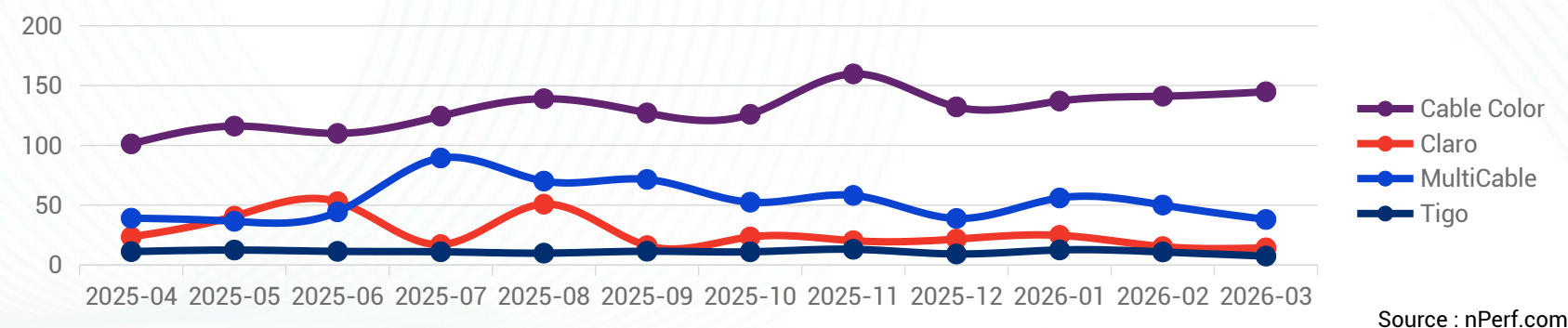

Upload Speed evolution over the year (average)





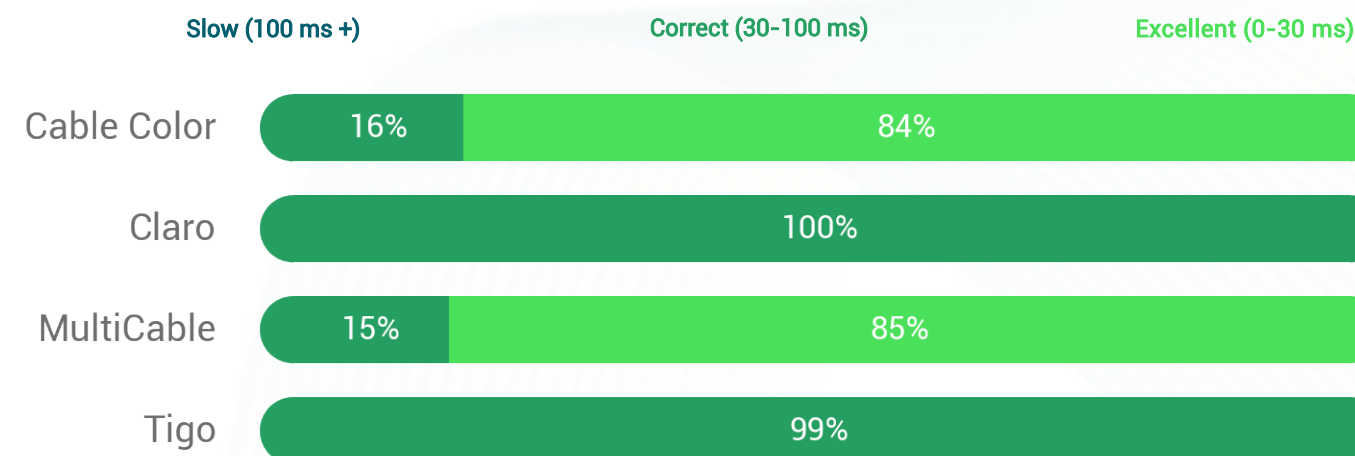

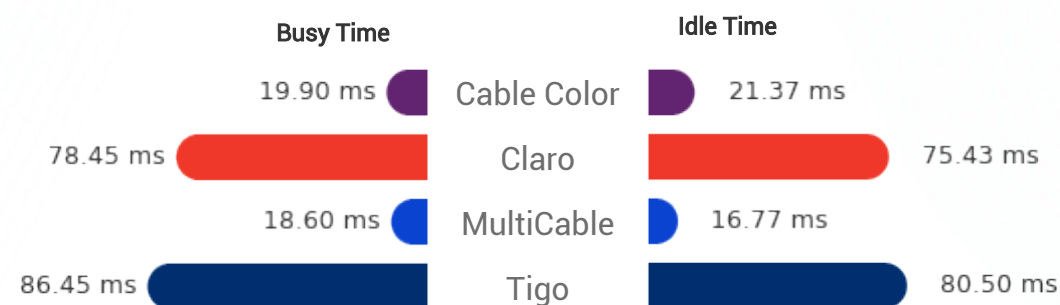

Latency results distribution (average)



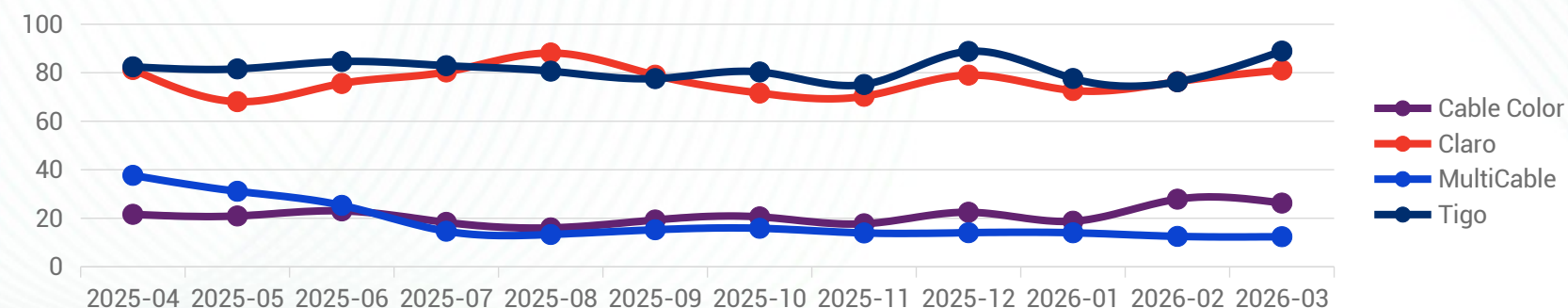

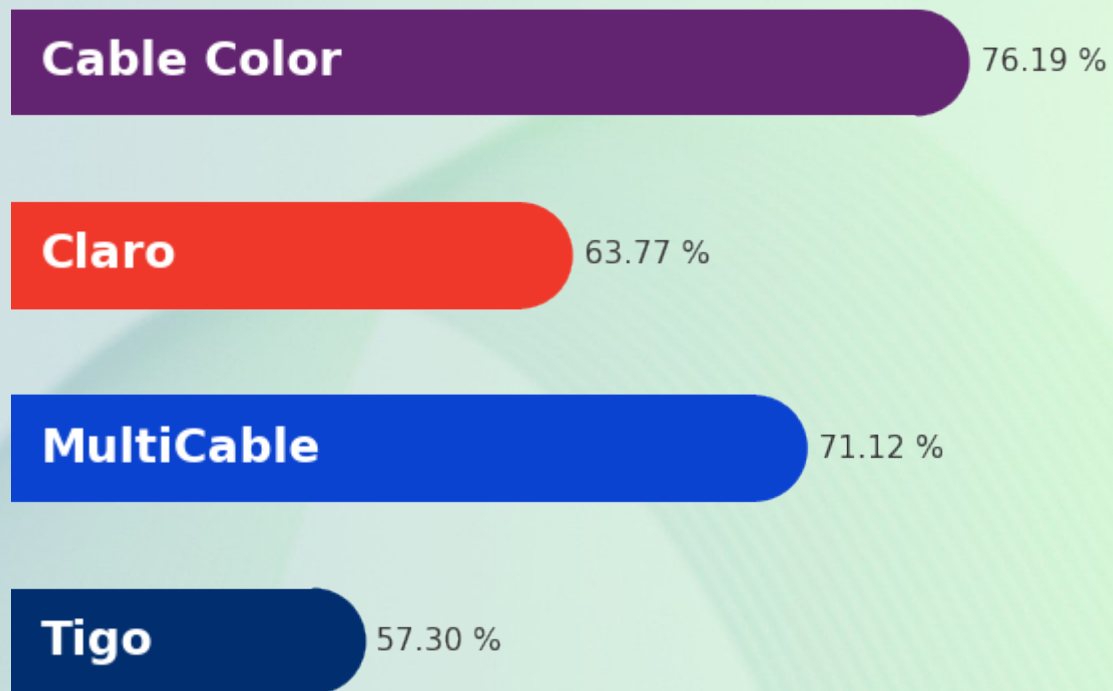
Latency evolution over the year (average)

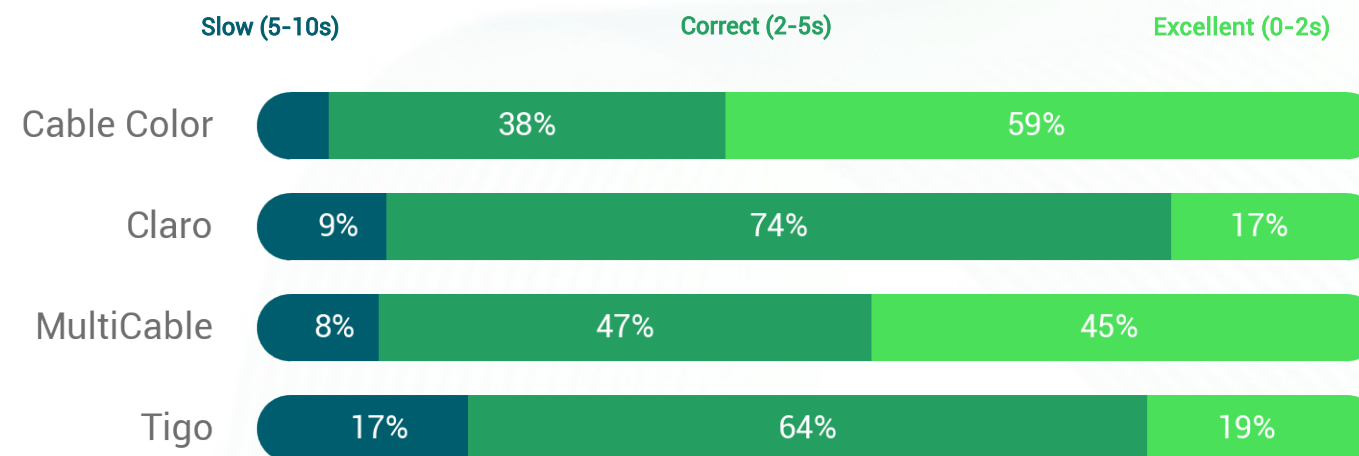

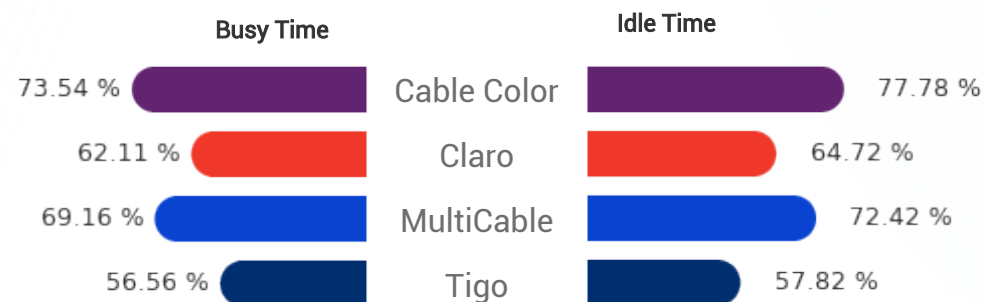

Browsing Performance results distribution (average)



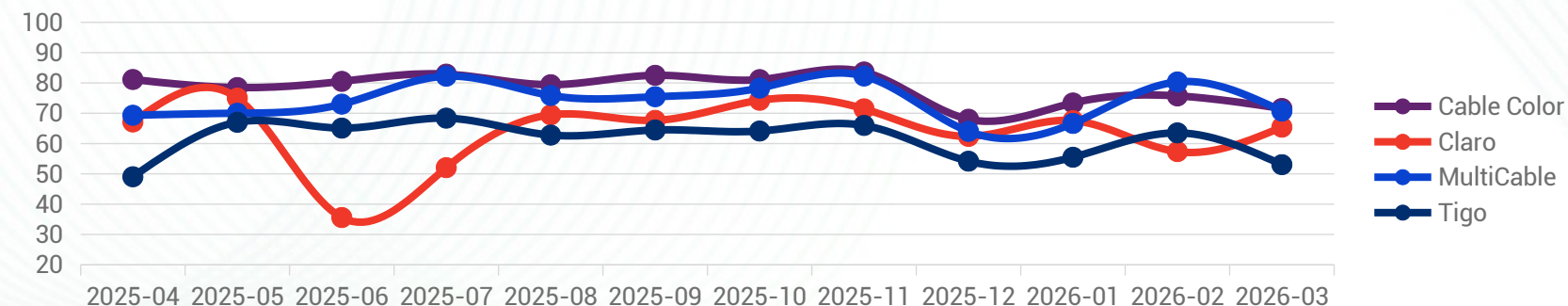

Browsing Performance evolution over the year (average)



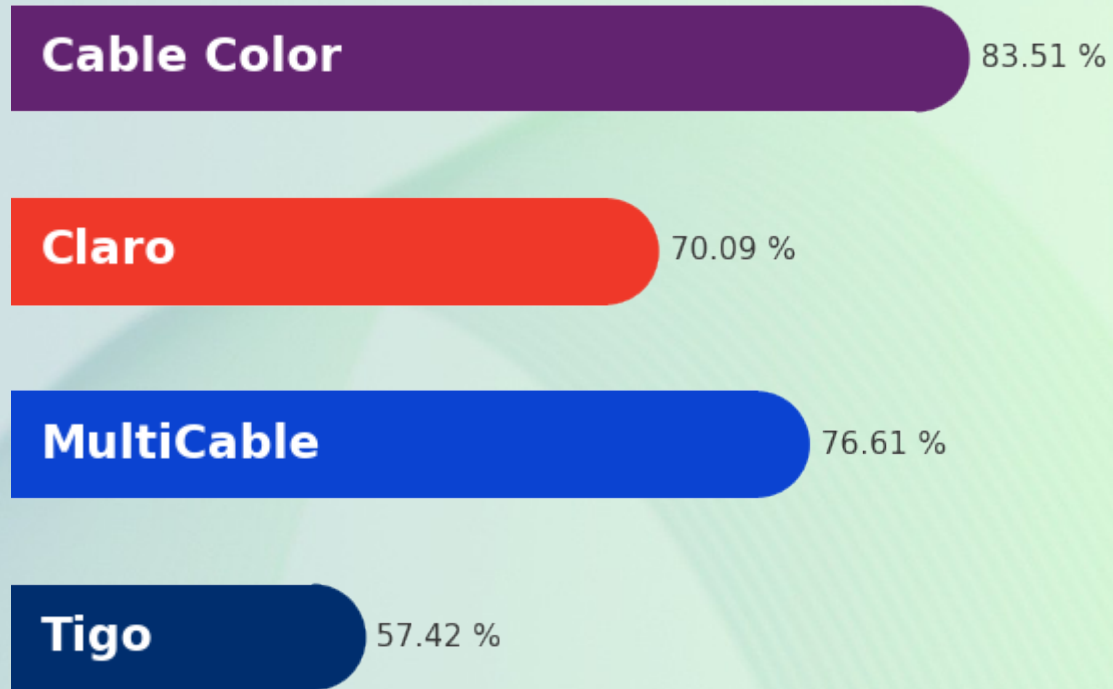

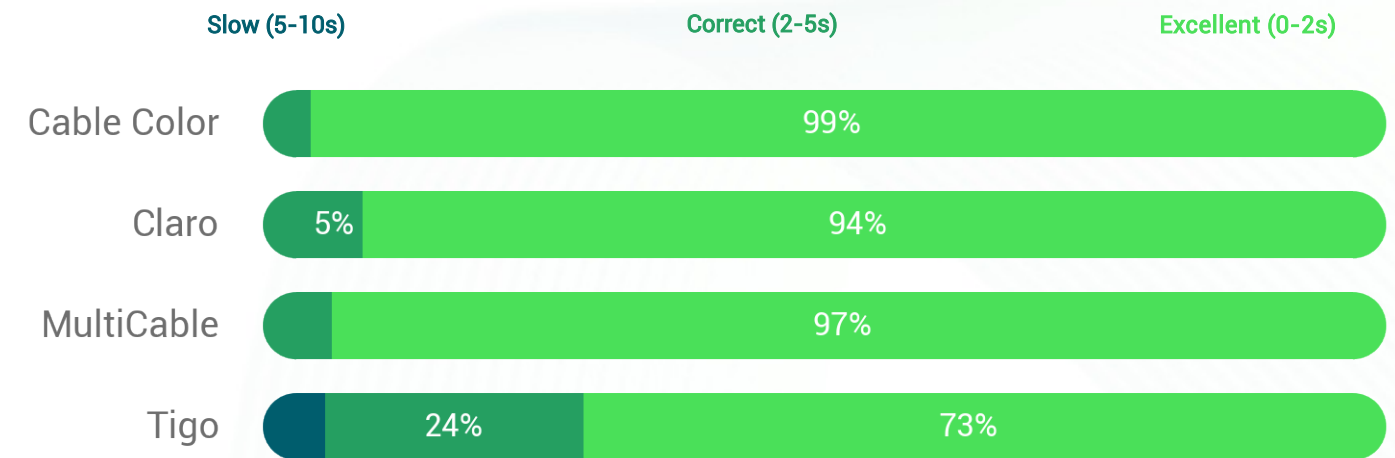

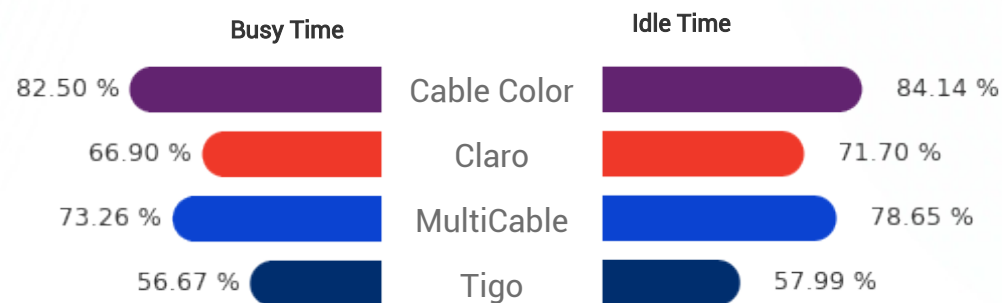

Streaming Performance results distribution (average)



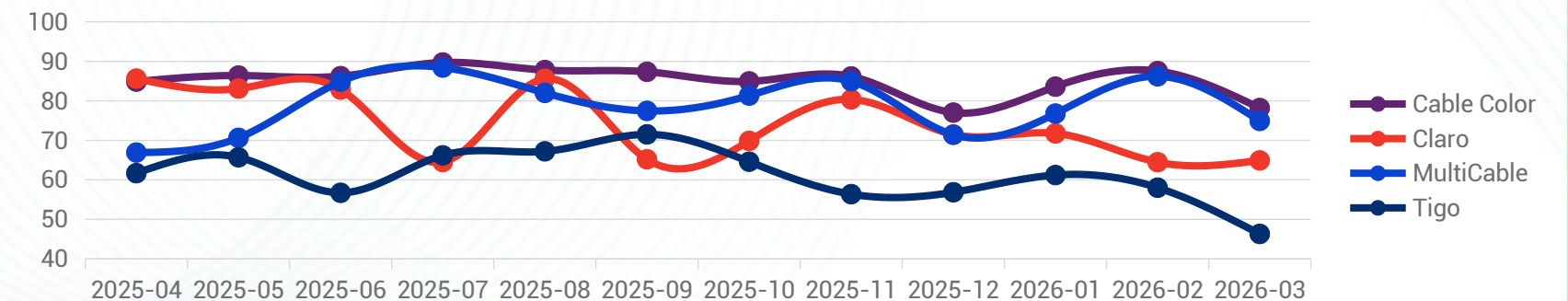

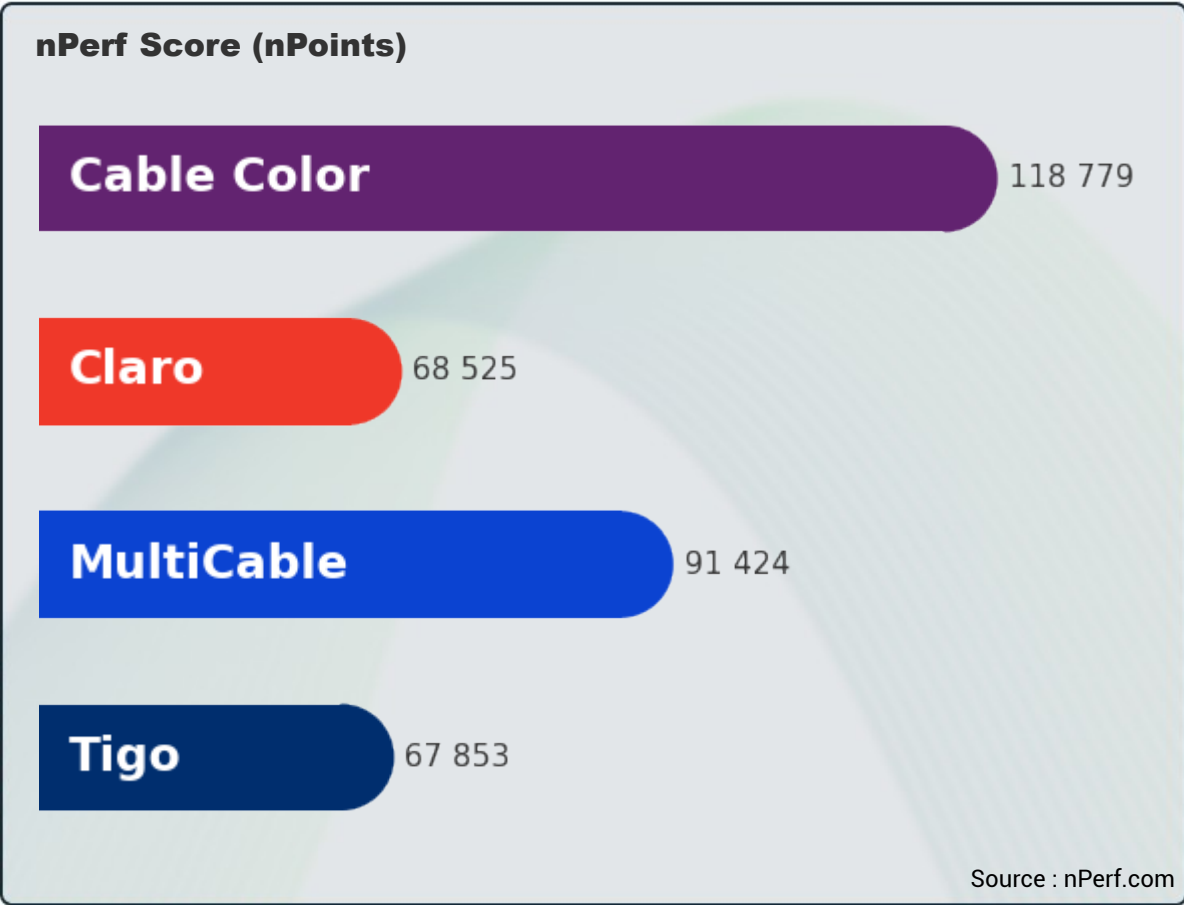

Streaming Performance evolution over the year (average)

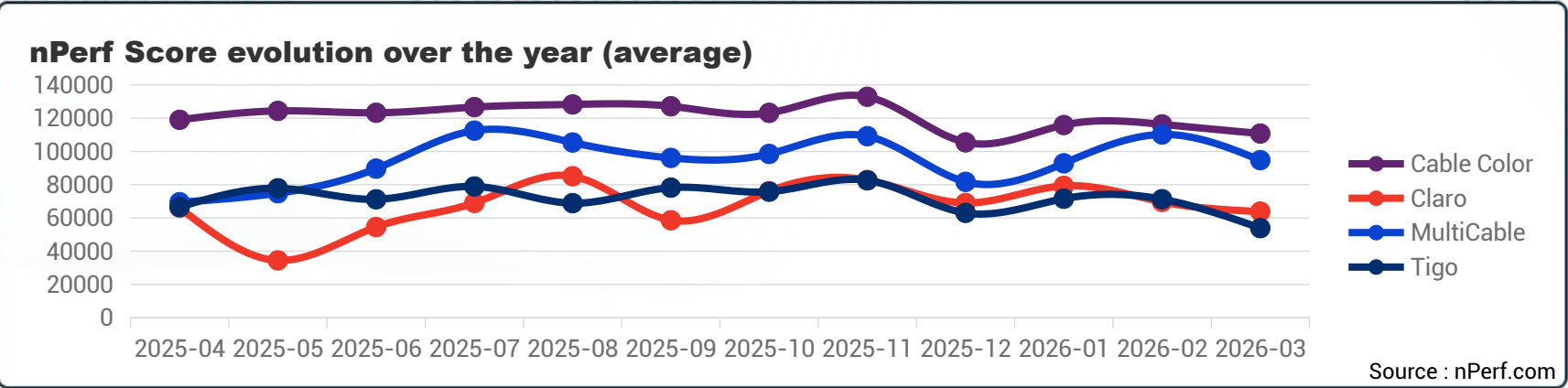
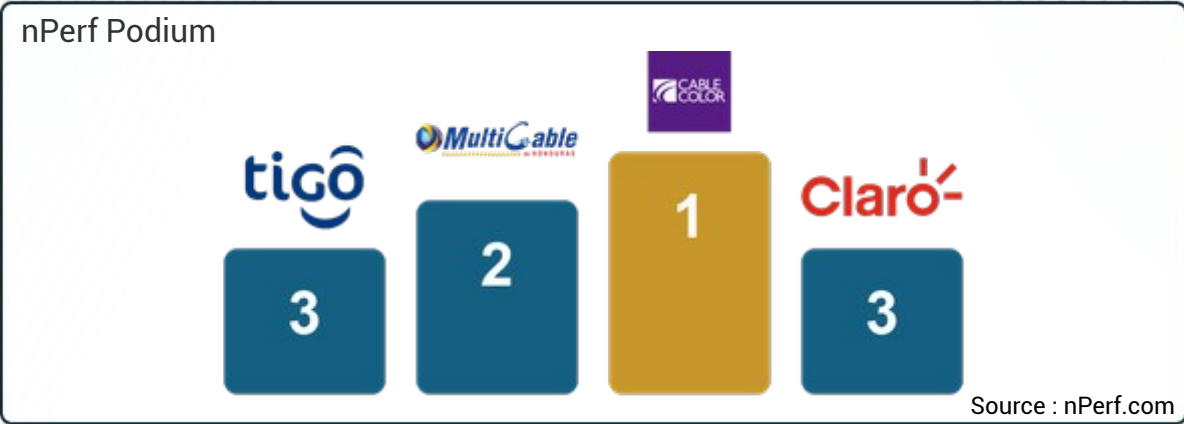

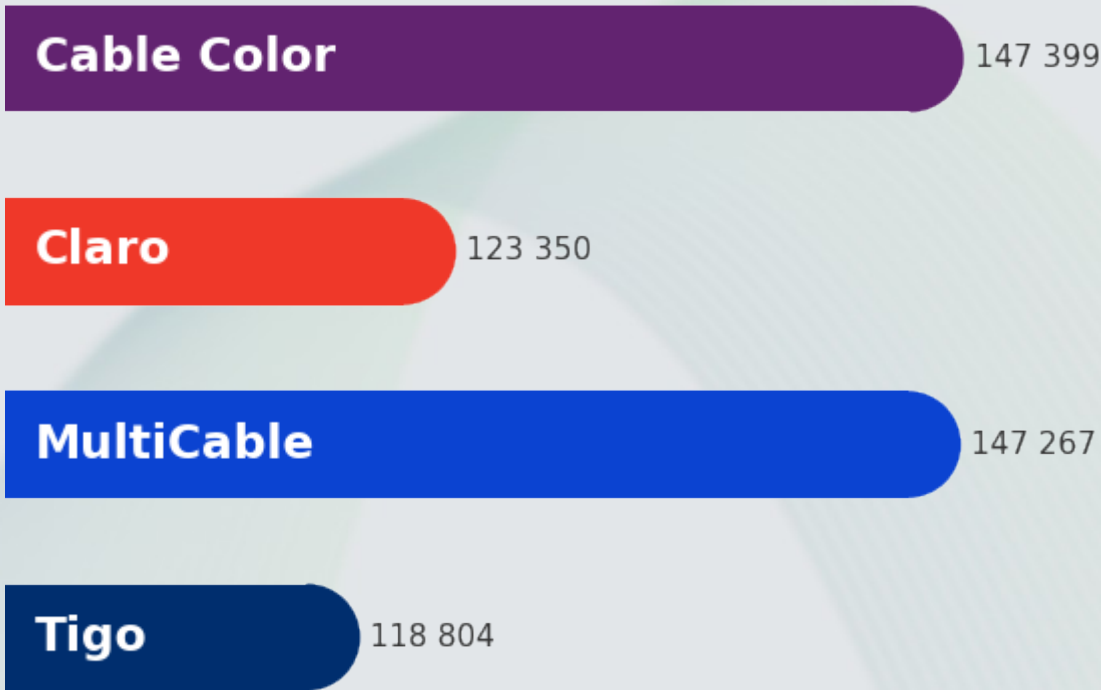

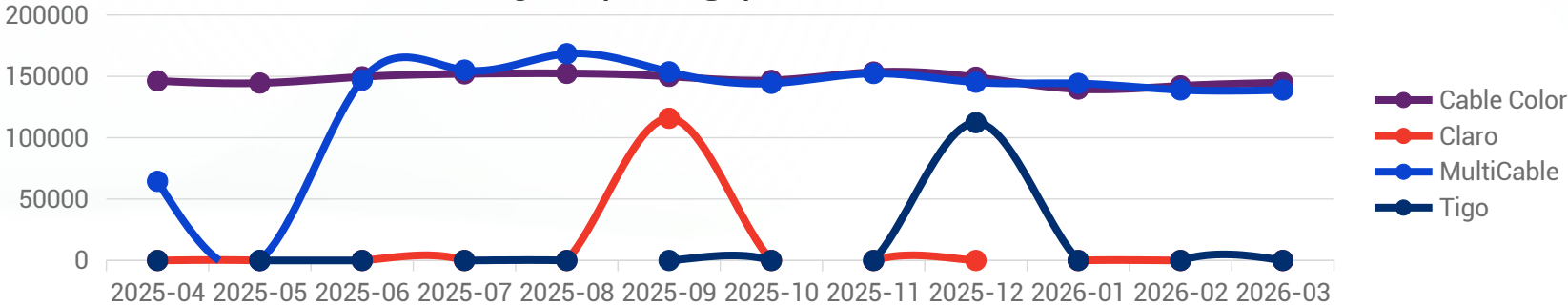

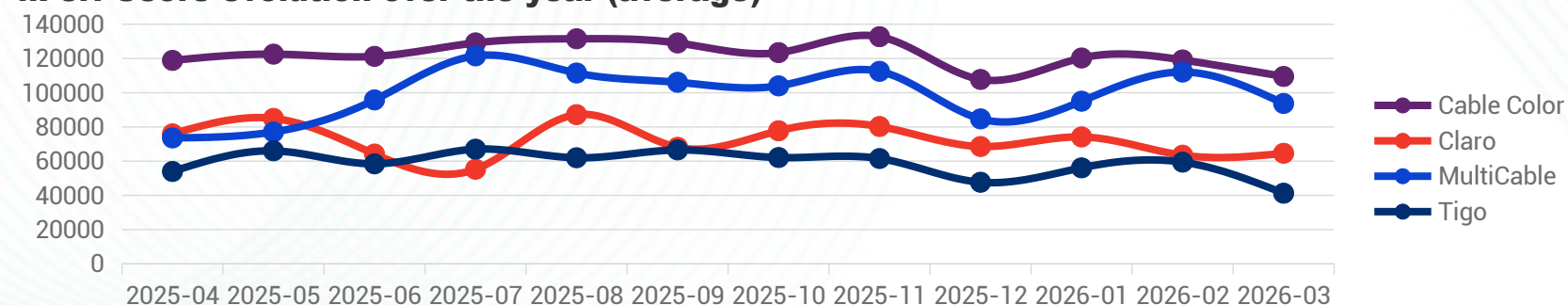
