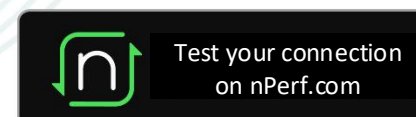

The best mobile Internet performance in Kyrgyzstan has been assessed by nPerf for the period April 2025 – March 2026, revealing a reshuffled competitive landscape among the country's three main operators – MegaCom, O!, and Beeline. This edition marks a notable shift at the top, with MegaCom claiming overall leadership for the first time, while O! and Beeline each demonstrate strengths across specific performance dimensions. All three operators show continued progress, reflecting a sector in steady improvement.

MegaCom: A historic rise to the top

After ranking third in the previous overall standings, MegaCom delivers a remarkable turnaround this year, climbing two positions to claim first place with a score of 49,859 – up from 47,384. This progression is not an isolated result: nPerf data confirms a consistent upward trend in MegaCom's overall score over five consecutive years. On 4G, MegaCom leads with a score of 51,717, topping the rankings for Download speed (Mb/s) (24.66 Mb/s) and Upload speed (Mb/s) (10.65 Mb/s), both sustained advantages held for five years. Most striking is MegaCom's latency performance: the operator reduces its overall Latency (ms) by an exceptional 65%, dropping from 153.40 ms to 54.32 ms – a first-ever leadership position on this indicator, both overall and on 4G.

O!: Consistent quality in user experience

O! holds second place overall with a score of 45,258, defending its position as the go-to operator for end-user experience indicators. For the third consecutive year, O! leads in Web Browsing (%) overall (56.92%) and on 4G (57.63%), and for the second consecutive year in Youtube streaming (%) overall (70.29%) and on 4G (70.82%). O! also

claims first place in Download speed (Mb/s) overall for the first time (24.07 Mb/s). Additionally, the operator reduces its overall Latency (ms) by 18% year-on-year, moving from 72.17 ms to 59.42 ms – a meaningful improvement, though latency remains its relative weakness.

Beeline: Reliable latency leader with resilient consistency

Beeline ranks third overall this year with a score of 44,458, after holding the top position in the previous period (51,741). Despite this drop in the overall standings, Beeline maintains a key distinction: it leads on Latency (ms) both overall (53.62 ms) and on 4G (53.47 ms), a performance it has sustained for five consecutive years – the longest uninterrupted leadership streak on this indicator in the Kyrgyz sector. nPerf also confirms a consistent five-year upward trend in Beeline's overall score, underlining the operator's structural reliability.

What to watch for next year

The Kyrgyz mobile sector is entering a more competitive phase, with MegaCom now setting the pace. To maintain its newly acquired leadership, MegaCom will need to consolidate its latency gains – which were dramatic this year – and strengthen its performance in Web Browsing (%) and Youtube streaming (%), where it still ranks second. O! must address its Upload speed (Mb/s) performance (2.05 Mb/s overall), the lowest among the three operators, while continuing to build on its user experience strengths. Beeline, for its part, faces the challenge of reversing its score decline and closing the gap with the leaders, particularly on Download speed (Mb/s) and Upload speed (Mb/s), to reclaim a podium position in the overall rankings.

4. Methodology



nPerf provides a free application to assess Internet connection quality via its website and mobile apps (Android, iOS). Daily, thousands of people rely on nPerf for speed tests in their country, contributing to a comprehensive crowdsourced database covering all operators.

The study employs a strong filtering method to reflect real customer experiences on a specific network (mobile or fixed line). Measures are taken to prevent probes and measurement robots from affecting the results.

We assess:

▼ Download bitrate

Indicates the amount of data your connection can receive in one second from the nPerf server. The highest the measured value, the best is the bitrate of your connection.

▲ Upload bitrate

Indicates the amount of data your connection can send in one second to the nPerf server. The highest the measured value, the best is the bitrate of your connection.

◄► Latency (ping)

It indicated the delay a small packet of data requires to make a round-trip from your computer to the nPerf server. The shorter the delay, the most reactive your connection is. The mean is the minimum value.

🌐 Browsing performance

The browsing test assesses the load time of the fully loaded pages, including images, javascript, CSS, and fonts, for the five most popular sites. This indicator reflects the perceived quality by the user.

📺 Streaming performance

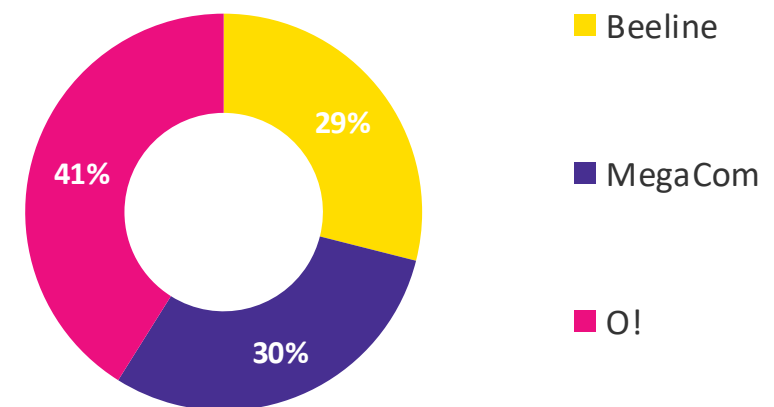
The video streaming test gauges the load time of a fully loaded video in three resolutions on YouTube, considering stalls during playback. This indicator reflects the perceived quality by the user.

Statistical precision is crucial in accurately determining winners. At nPerf, we prioritize test quality, precise reporting, and transparency. Analyzing a large volume of tests in this study, we've achieved 1.5% precision for absolute values and 1% point for percentage-based results, highlighting the reliability and accuracy of our data.

For a more comprehensive understanding of the user experience, our report takes into account test results during both Busy Hours (6 PM to 11 PM) and Idle Hours (the rest of the day). Busy Hours, marked by network strain, can impact user experience through congestion. This approach helps in understanding how network performance fluctuates throughout the day.

We only include national Internet service providers with test share above 5% share. The chart below shows the overall test distribution for each service provider.

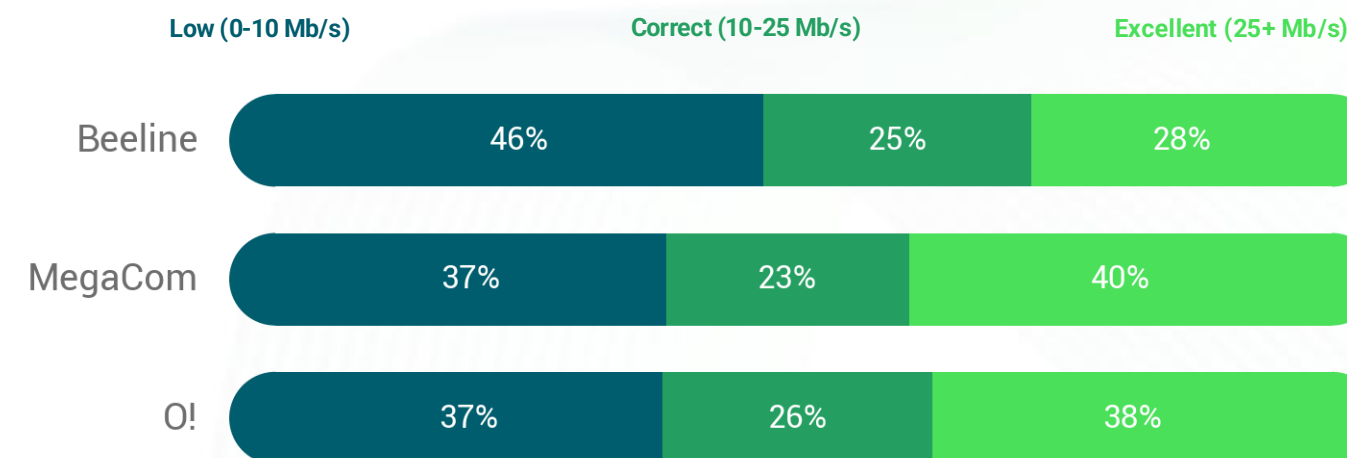

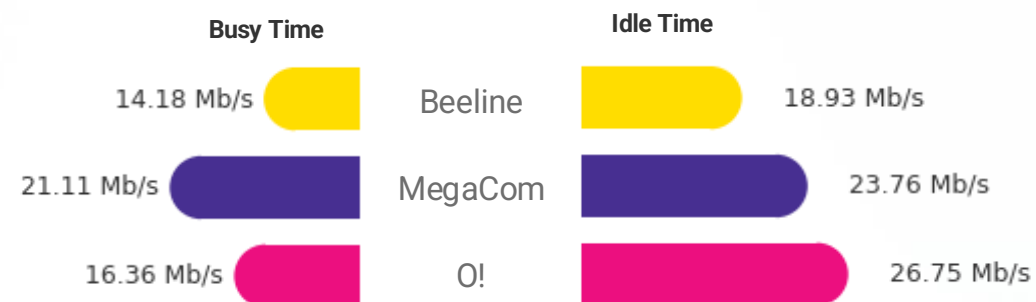

Download Speed results distribution (average)



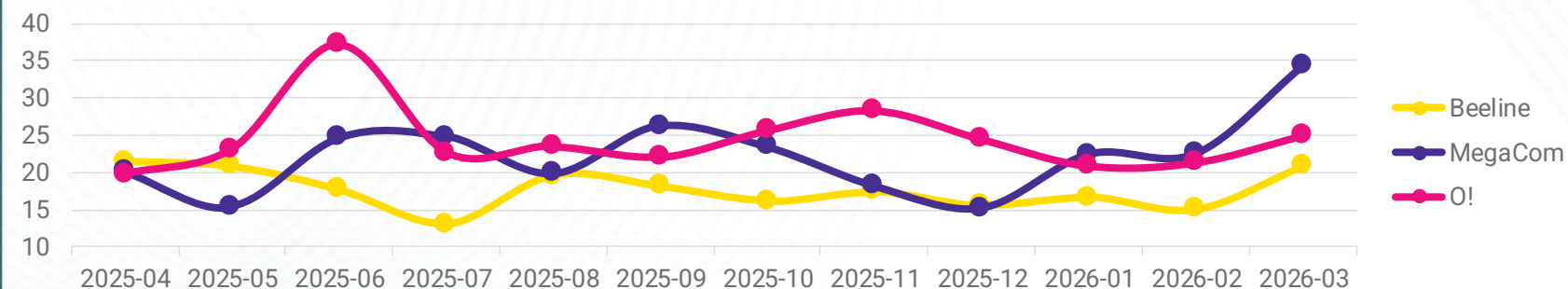

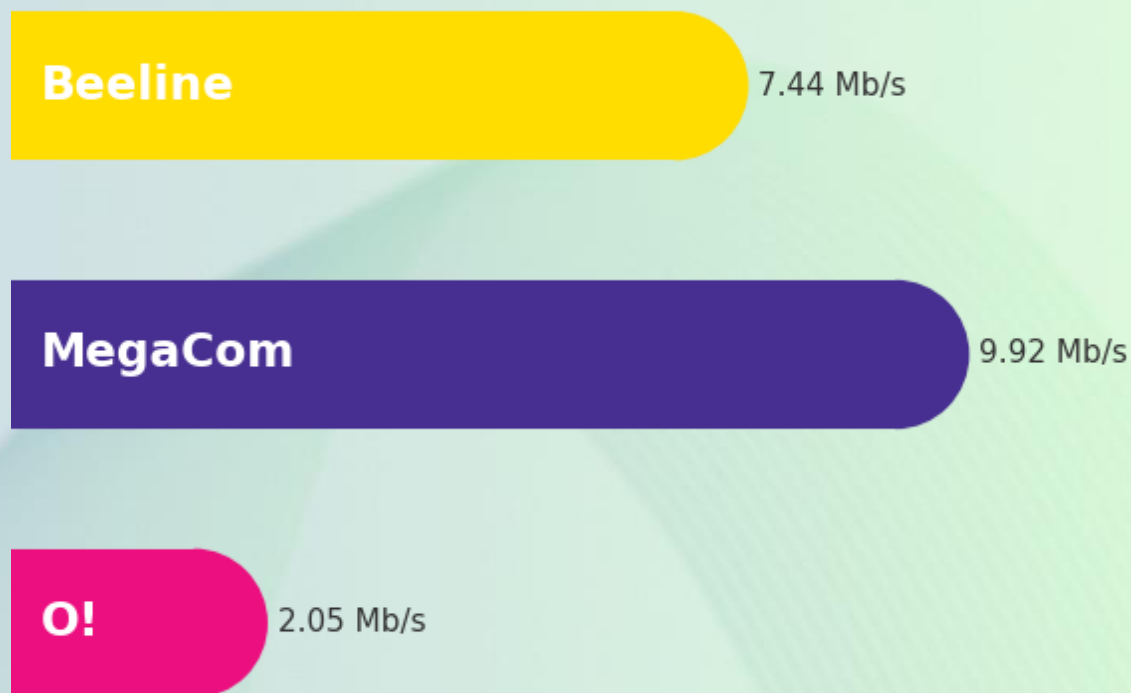

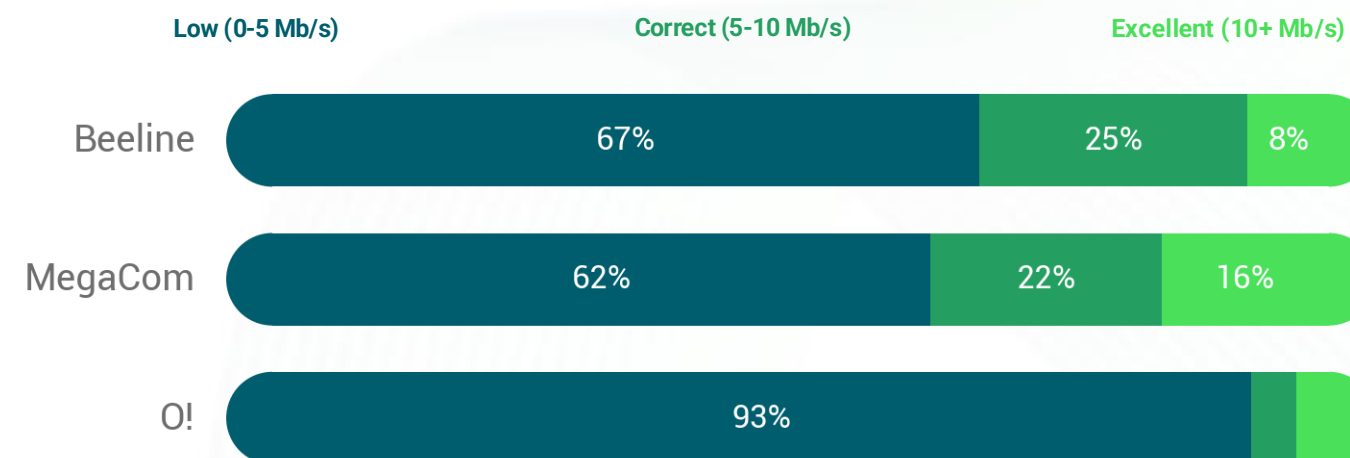

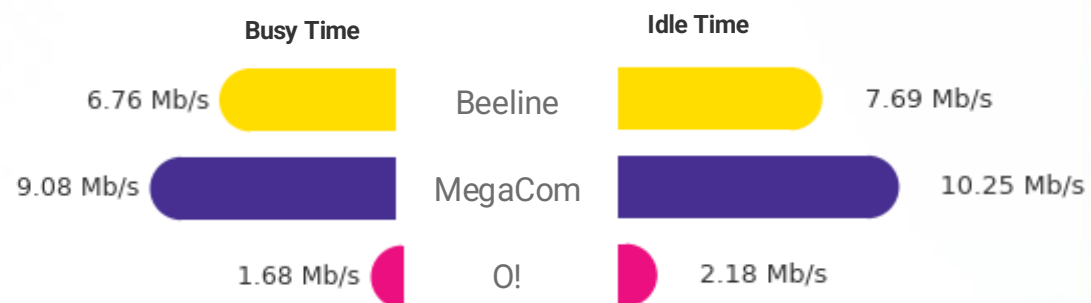

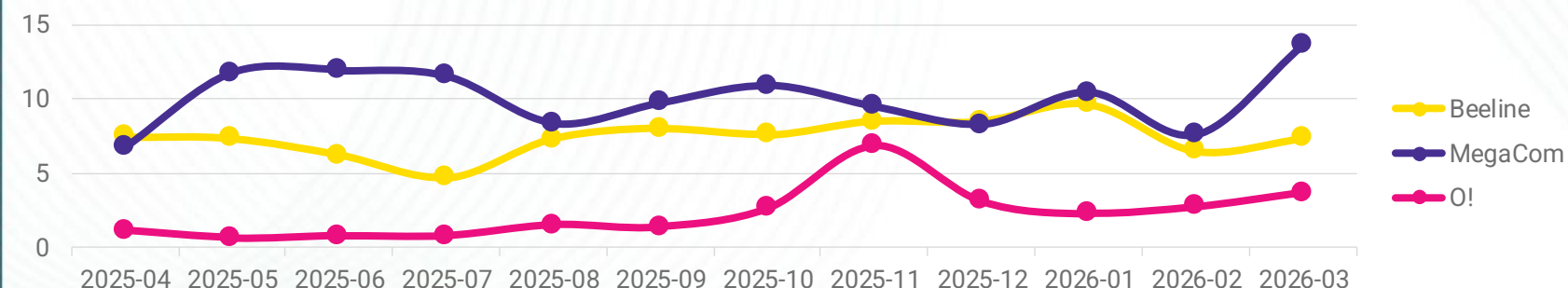

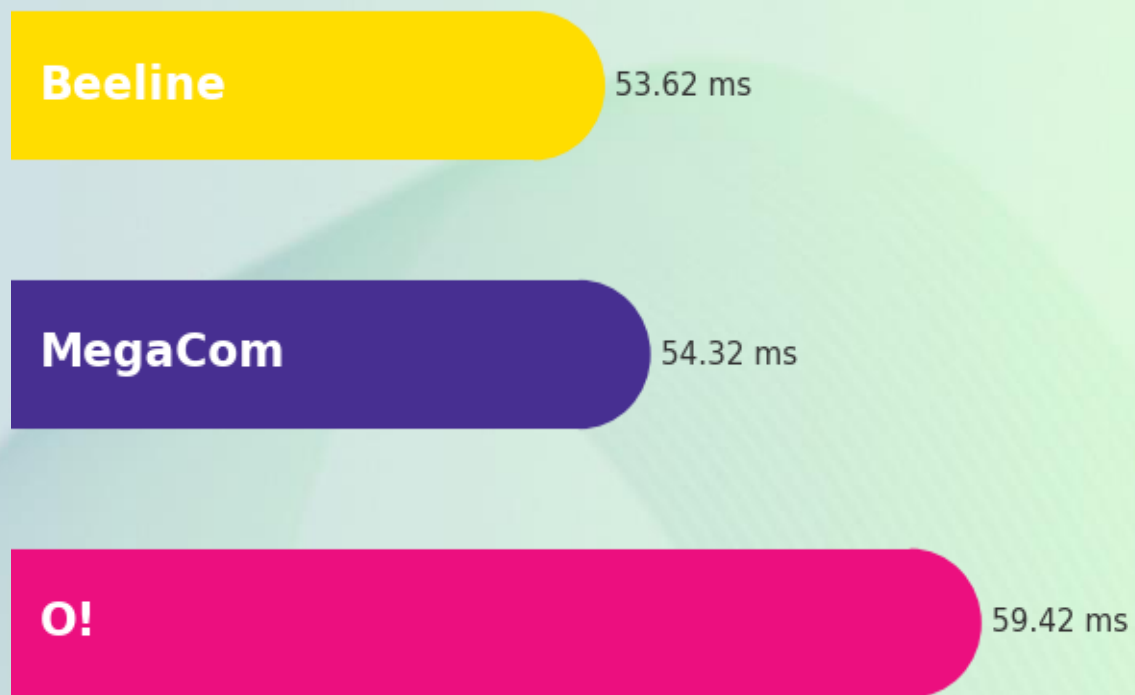
Upload Speed evolution over the year (average)

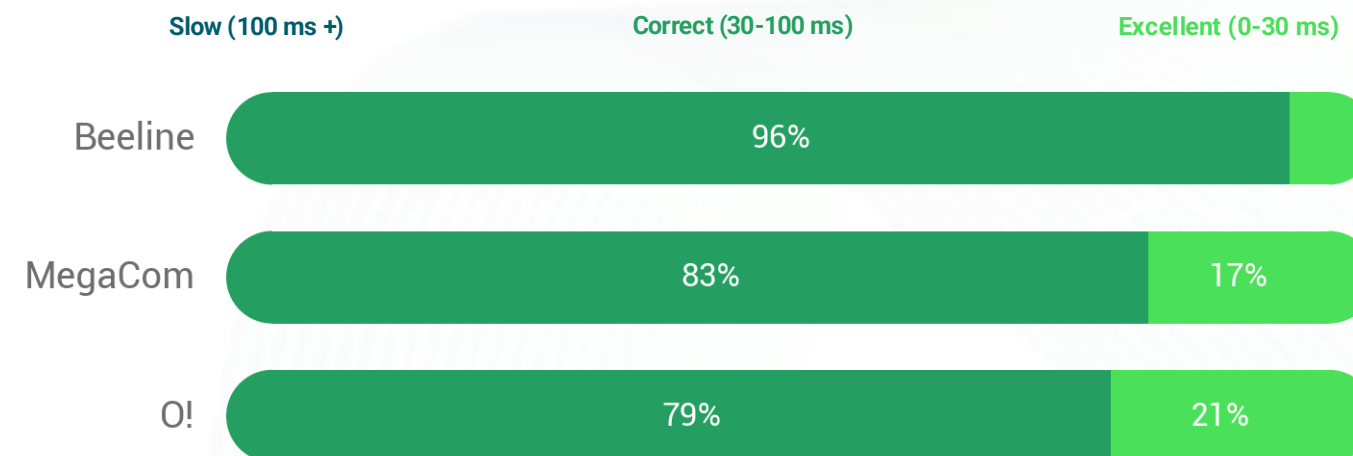

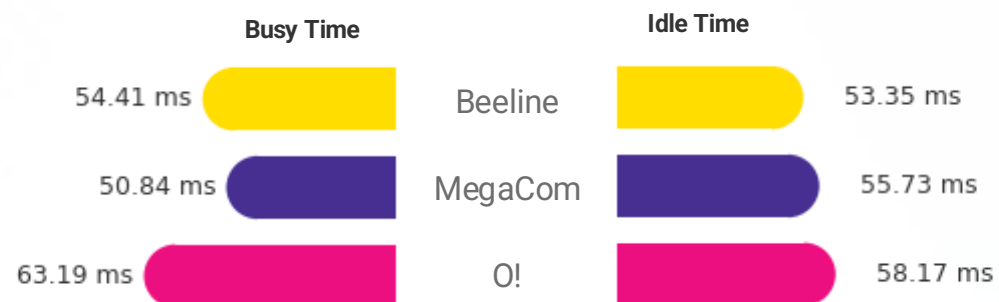

Latency results distribution (average)



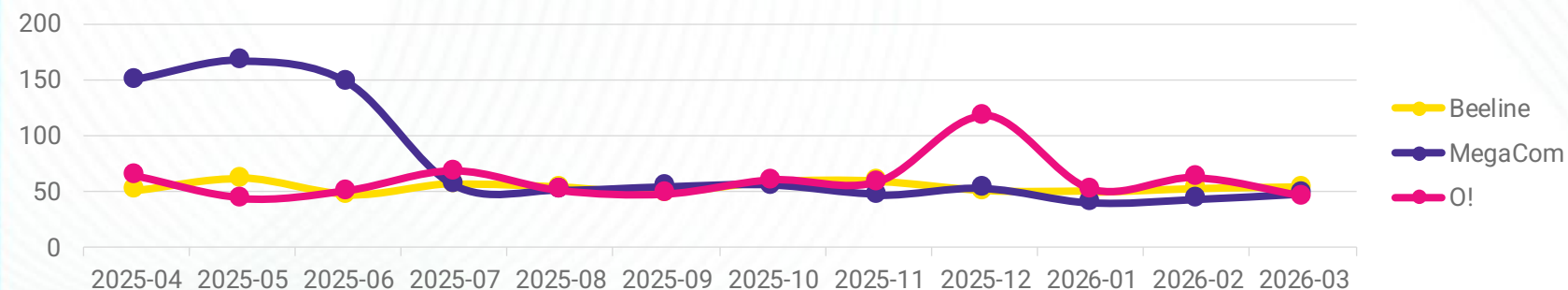

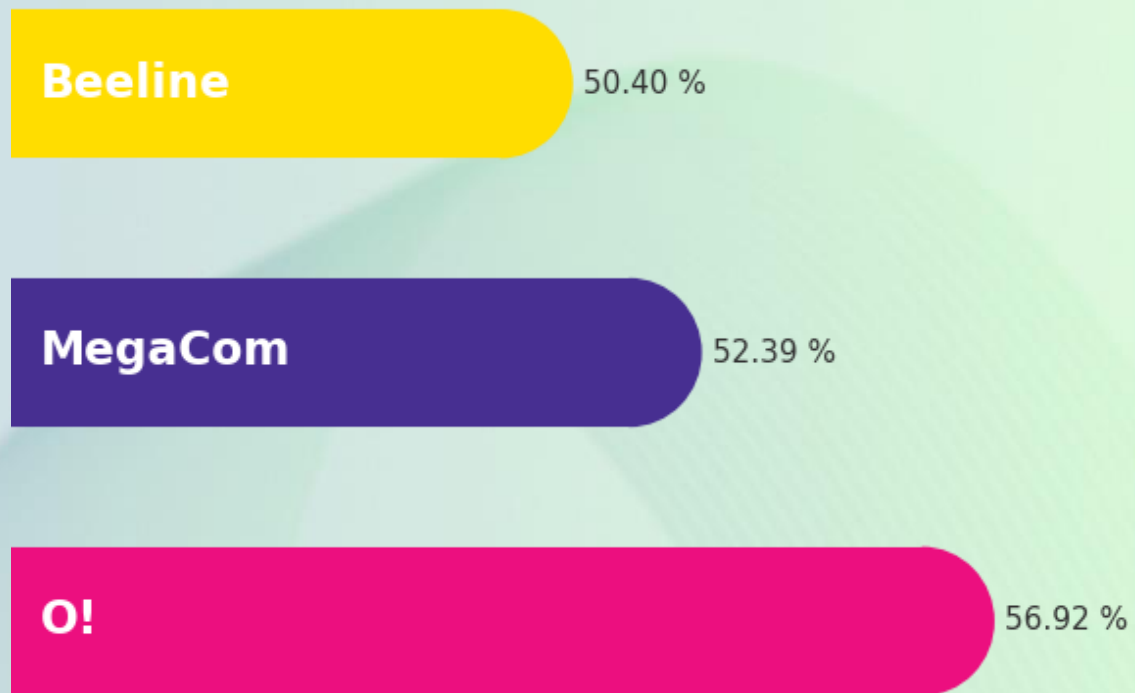
Latency evolution over the year (average)

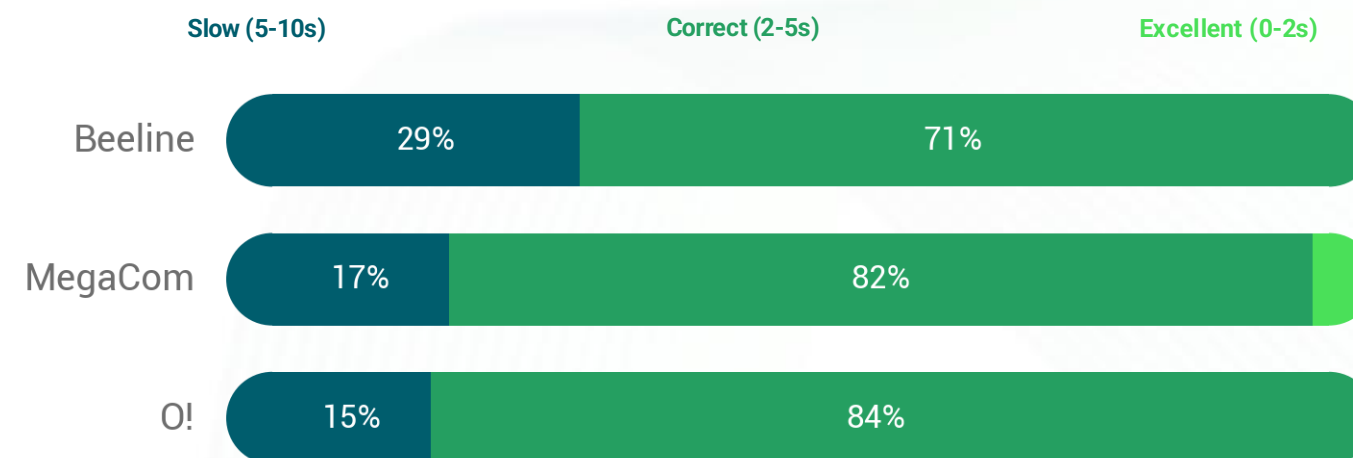

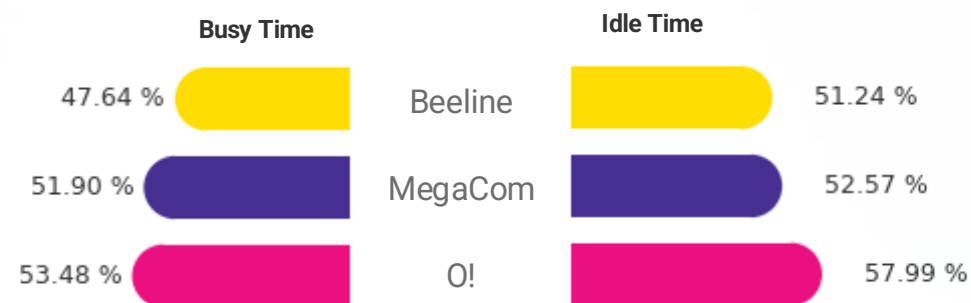

Browsing Performance results distribution (average)



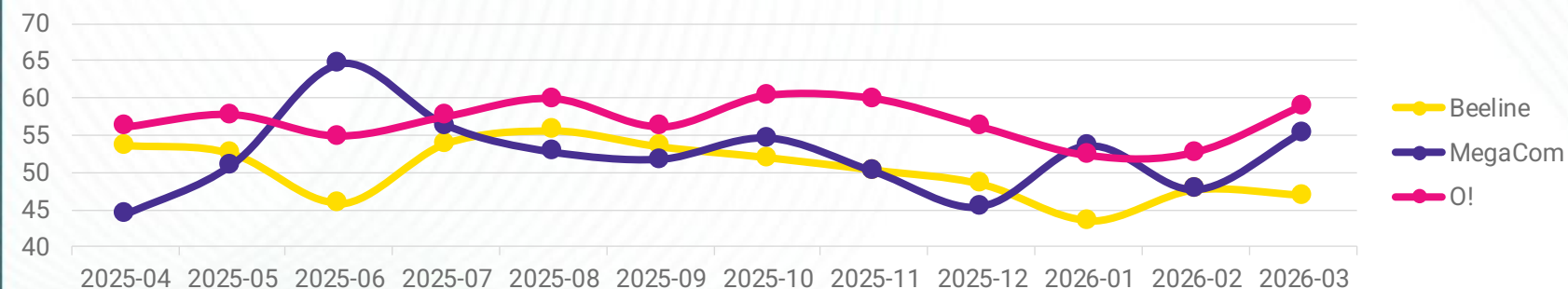

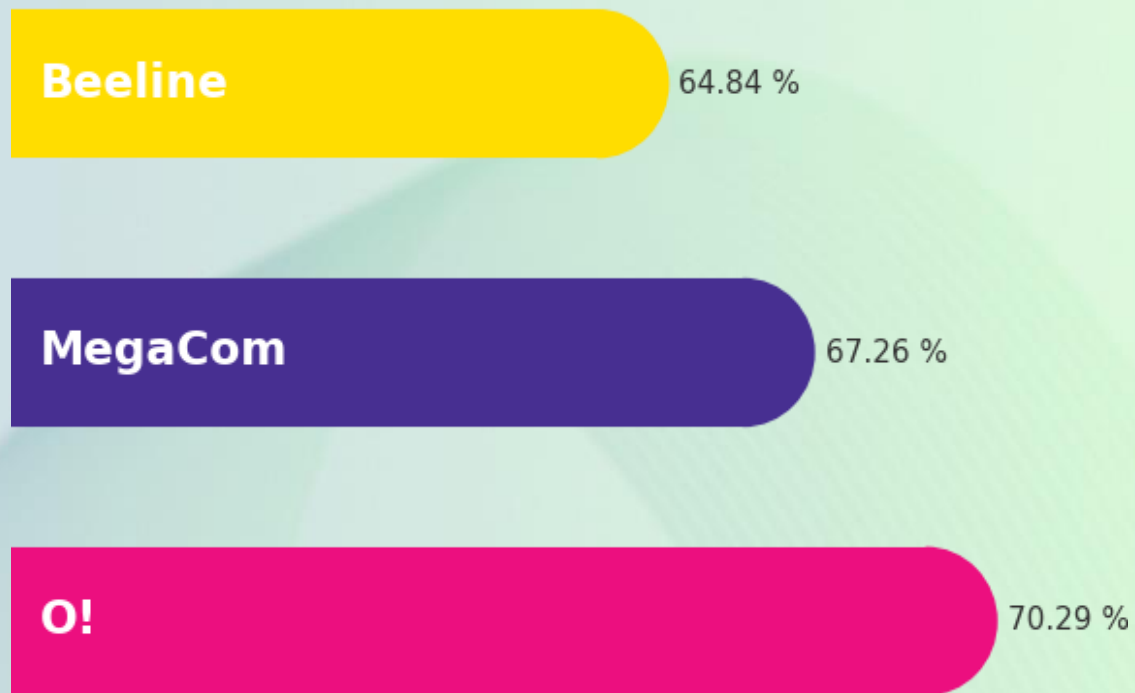
Browsing Performance evolution over the year (average)

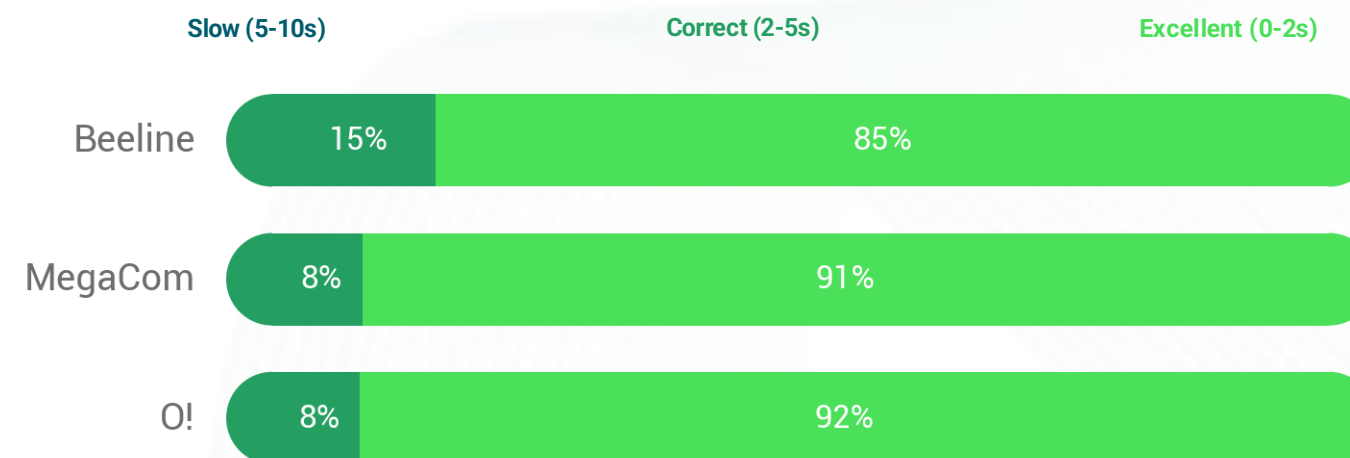

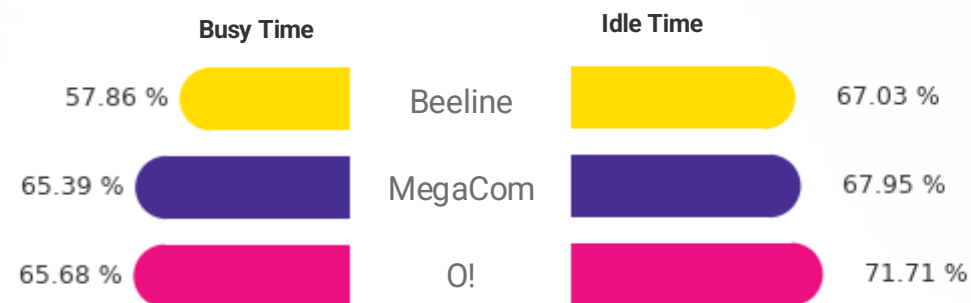

Streaming Performance results distribution (average)



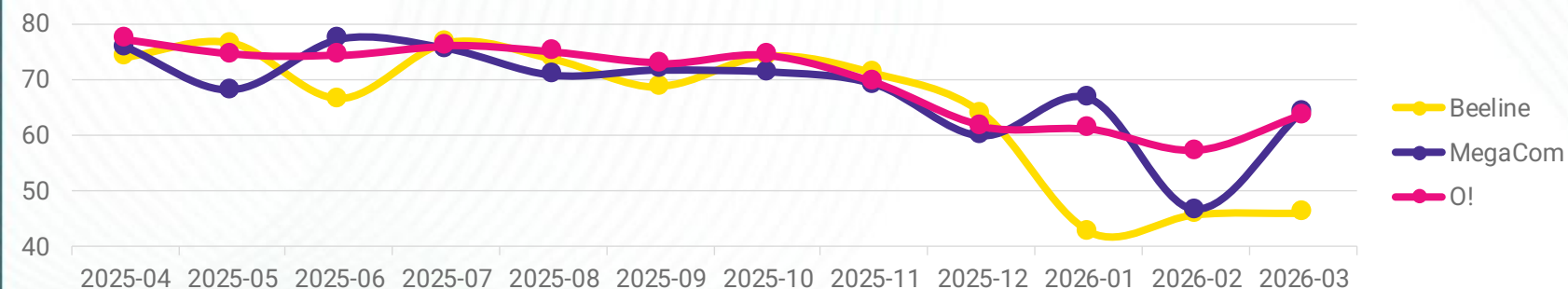

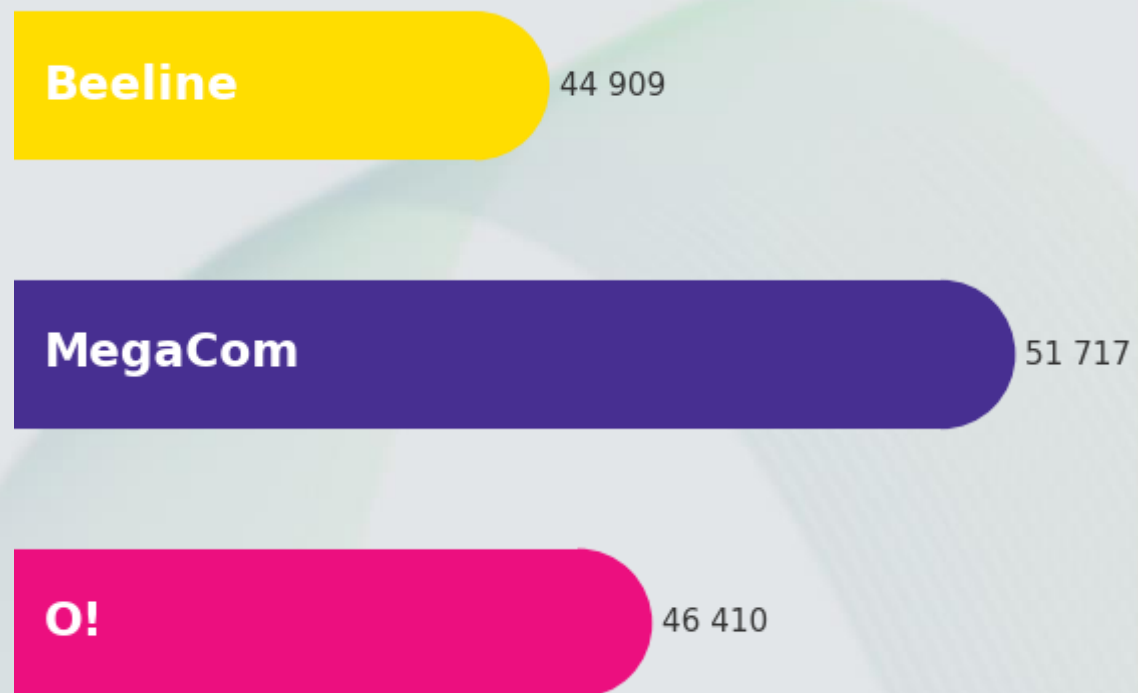

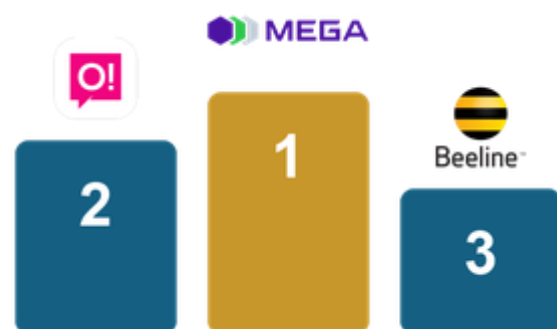

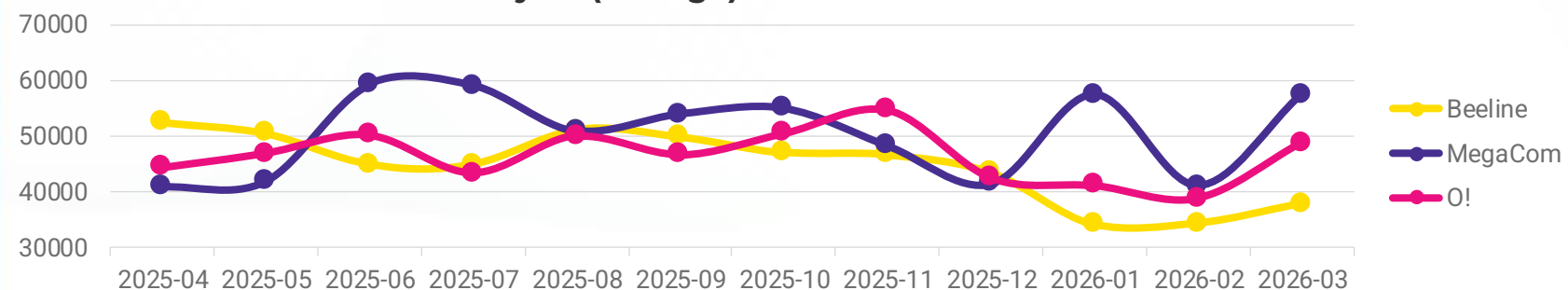

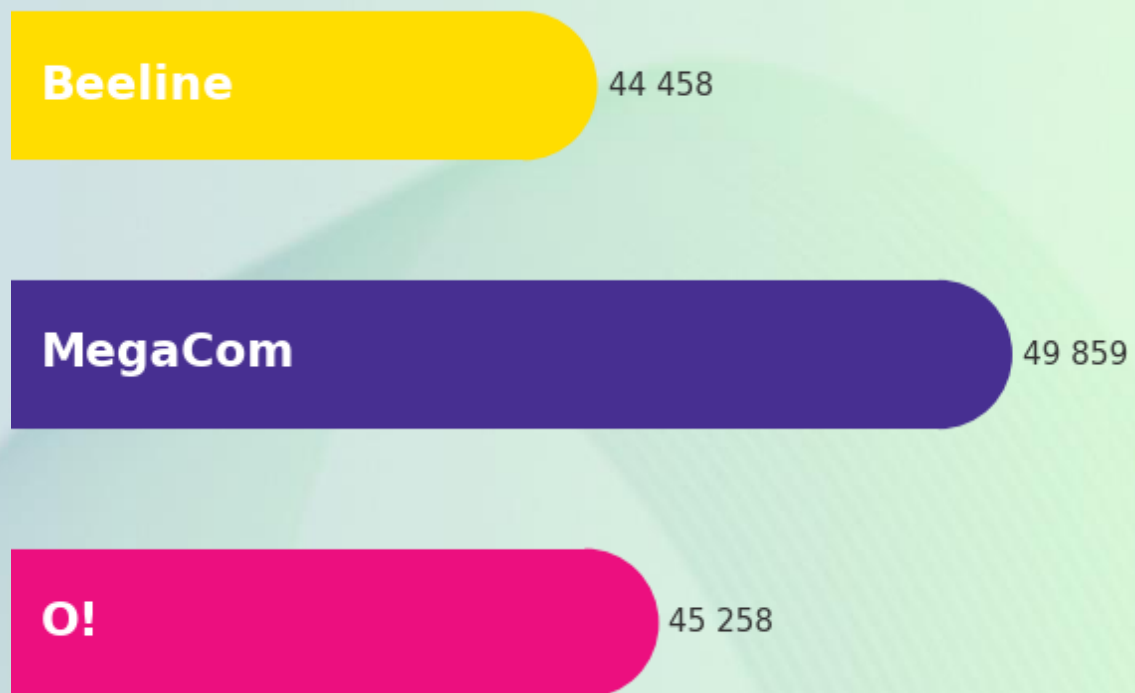
nPerf Score evolution over the year (average)

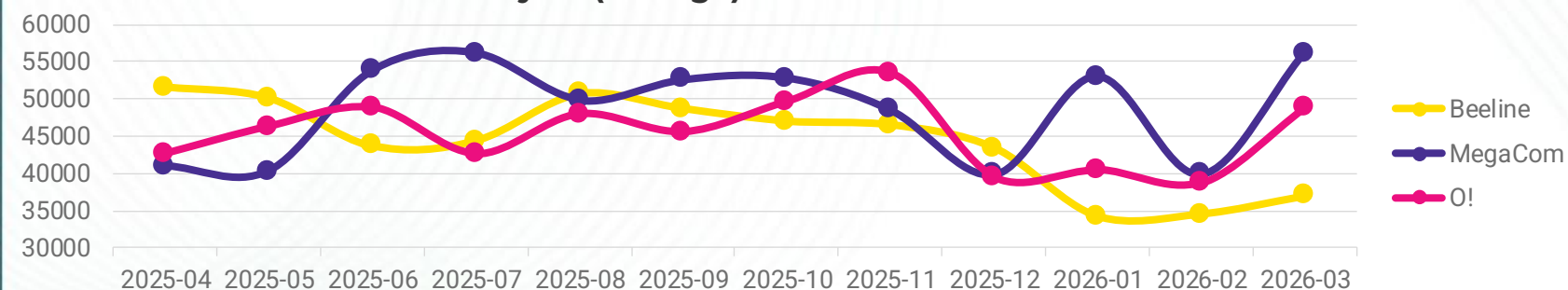
