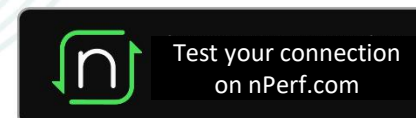

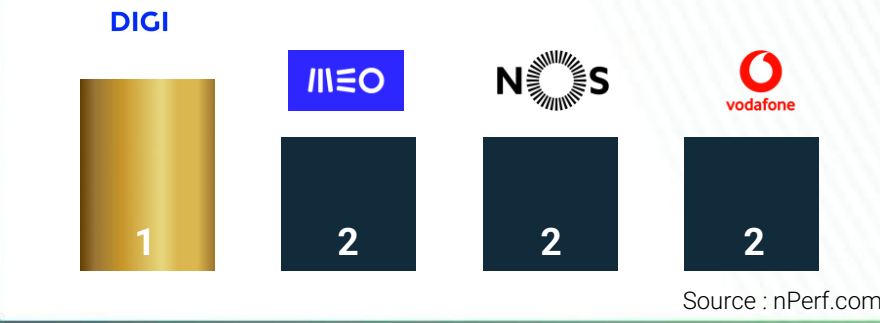

The Portuguese fixed-line Internet sector displays an average score of 136,541 nPoints. Digi establishes itself as leader with 156,710 nPoints and dominates across download speed, upload speed, and all user experience metrics. The sector is characterized by strong competition among the top three operators and significant performance gaps, with Digi surging ahead by 18.3%.

DIGI : a consolidated leadership position

Digi leads the sector with 156,710 nPoints and records a strong progression of 18.3%. The operator dominates download speed with 642.64 Mbps, ideal for HD streaming and large file downloads. It also leads upload speed with 521.86 Mbps, ensuring high-quality video conferencing and seamless content sharing. Leader in browsing (78.37%) and video streaming (86.33%), Digi delivers a well-balanced user experience. The operator also achieves the best latency performance at 14.27 ms, perfect for online gaming and real-time communications.

Vodafone: competitive performances

Vodafone ranks second with 131,440 nPoints and delivers solid download speed at 278.29 Mbps, suitable for streaming and

downloads. The operator secures second place in upload speed with 165.96 Mbps and browsing performance (76.73%).

NOS: optimal latency

NOS ranks third with 129,036 nPoints and achieves the second-best latency in the sector at 16.38 ms, ideal for online gaming and real-time applications. The operator progresses by 2.8%.

MEO: strong streaming performance

MEO ranks fourth with 128,976 nPoints and distinguishes itself in video streaming (84.75%, 2nd place). The operator secures third place in upload speed with 155.66 Mbps, ensuring quality video calls.

Digi consolidates its leadership with dominant performances across all metrics. The sector shows positive dynamics with three operators progressing year-over-year. Users benefit from increasingly competitive offers, particularly for streaming, gaming, and professional applications requiring high upload speeds.

4. Methodology



nPerf provides a free application to assess Internet connection quality via its website and mobile apps (Android, iOS). Daily, thousands of people rely on nPerf for speed tests in their country, contributing to a comprehensive crowdsourced database covering all operators.

The study employs a strong filtering method to reflect real customer experiences on a specific network (mobile or fixed line). Measures are taken to prevent probes and measurement robots from affecting the results.

We assess:

▼ Download bitrate

Indicates the amount of data your connection can receive in one second from the nPerf server. The highest the measured value, the best is the bitrate of your connection.

▲ Upload bitrate

Indicates the amount of data your connection can send in one second to the nPerf server. The highest the measured value, the best is the bitrate of your connection.

◄► Latency (ping)

It indicated the delay a small packet of data requires to make a round-trip from your computer to the nPerf server. The shorter the delay, the most reactive your connection is. The mean is the minimum value.

Browsing performance

The browsing test assesses the load time of the fully loaded pages, including images, javascript, CSS, and fonts, for the five most popular sites. This indicator reflects the perceived quality by the user.

Streaming performance

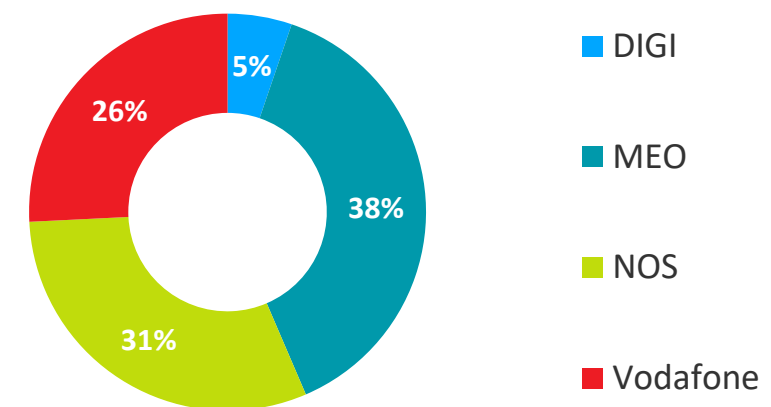
The video streaming test gauges the load time of a fully loaded video in three resolutions on YouTube, considering stalls during playback. This indicator reflects the perceived quality by the user.

Statistical precision is crucial in accurately determining winners. At nPerf, we prioritize test quality, precise reporting, and transparency. Analyzing a large volume of tests in this study, we've achieved 1.1% precision for absolute values and 1% point for percentage-based results, highlighting the reliability and accuracy of our data.

For a more comprehensive understanding of the user experience, our report takes into account test results during both Busy Hours (6 PM to 11 PM) and Idle Hours (the rest of the day). Busy Hours, marked by network strain, can impact user experience through congestion. This approach helps in understanding how network performance fluctuates throughout the day.

We only include national Internet service providers with test share above 5% share. The chart below shows the overall test distribution for each service provider.

Overall distribution of the tests per provider (ISPs Share)



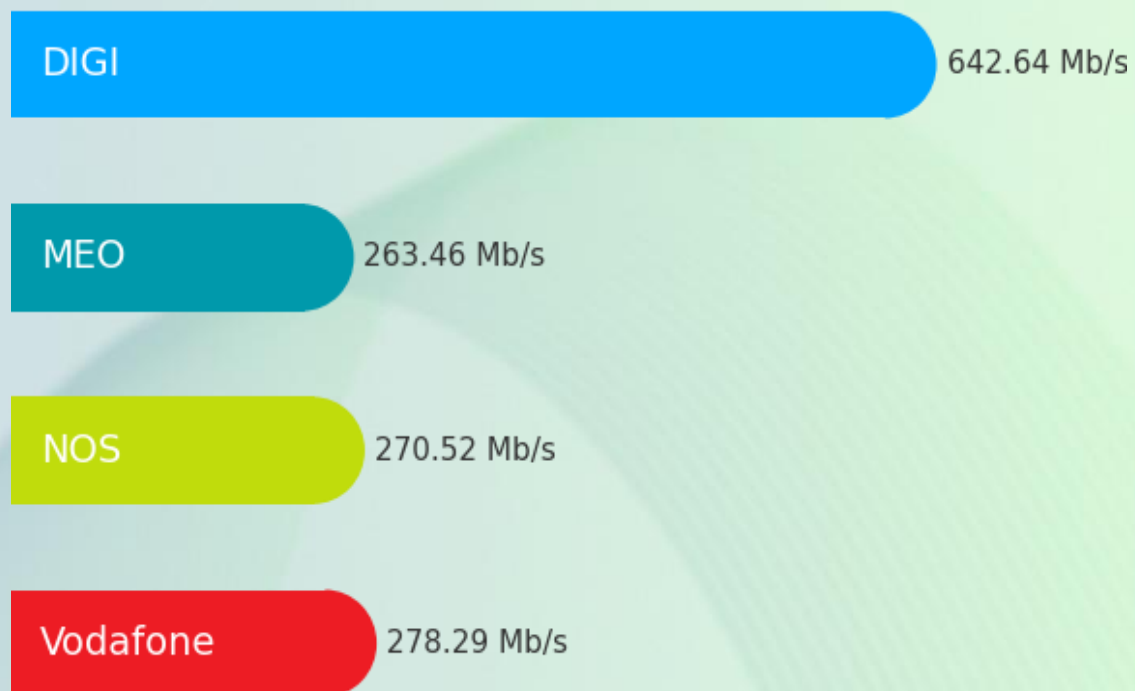

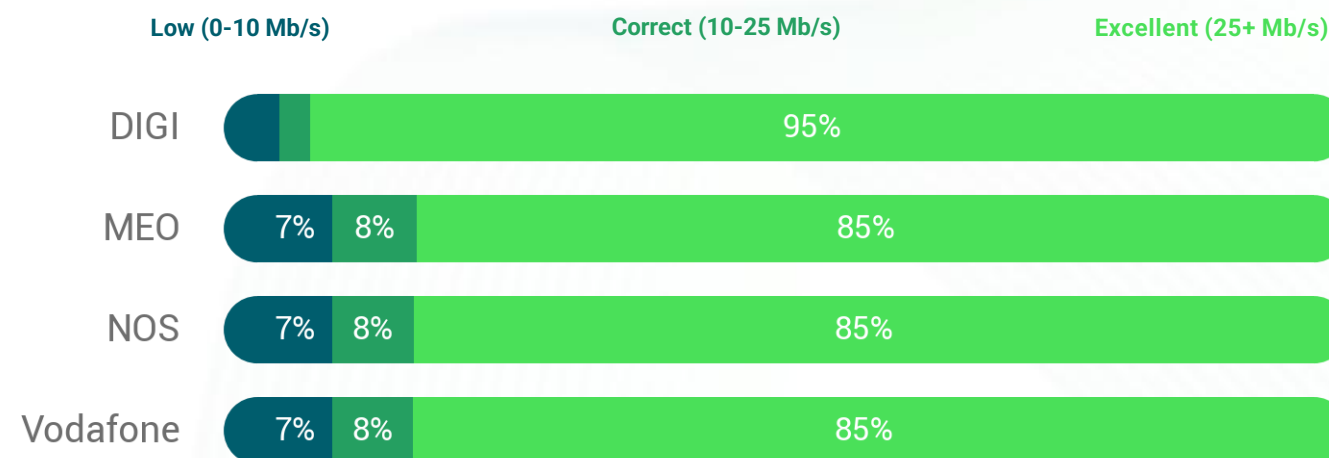

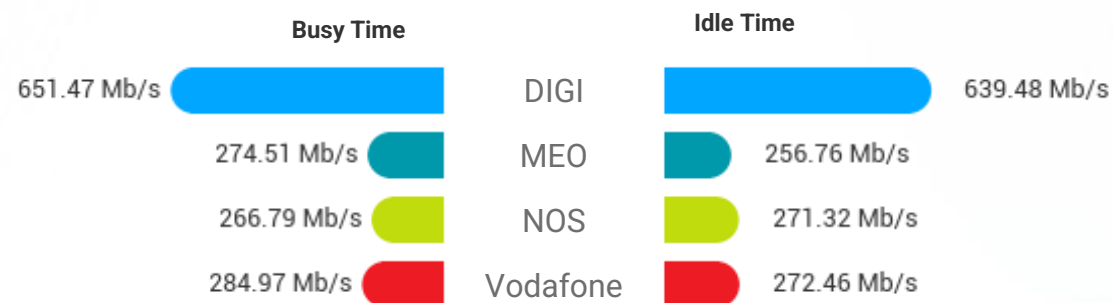

Download Speed results ventilation (average)



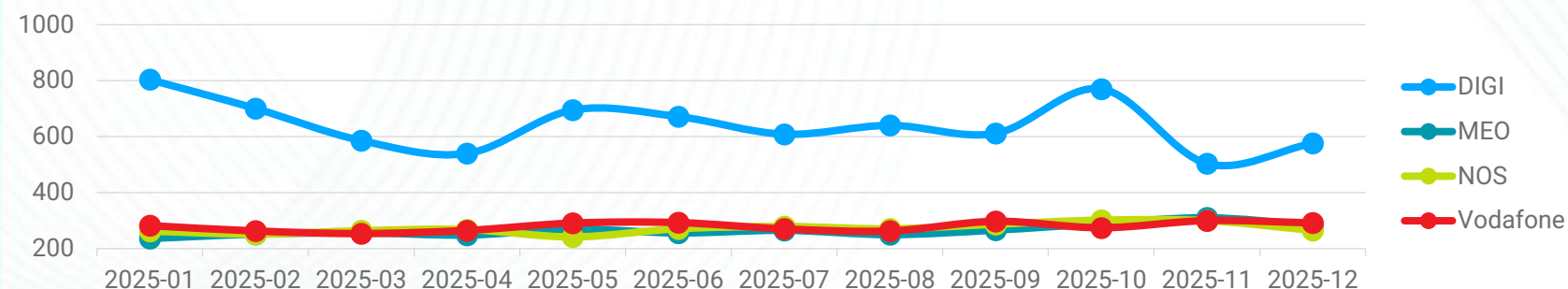

Download Speed evolution over the year (average)



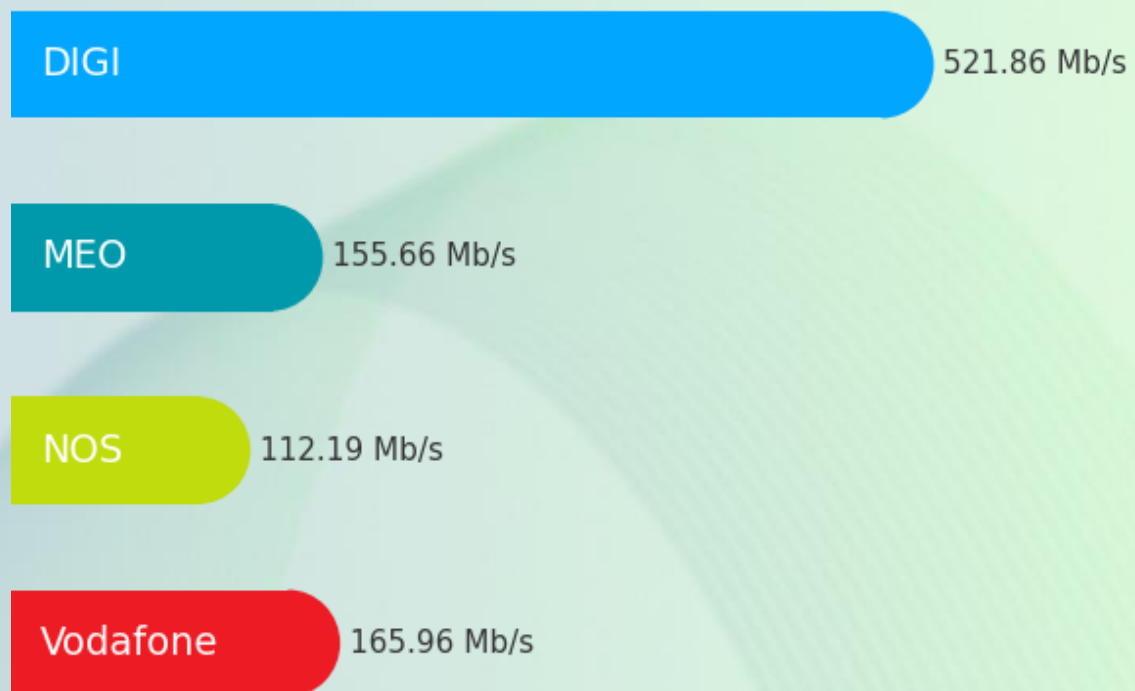

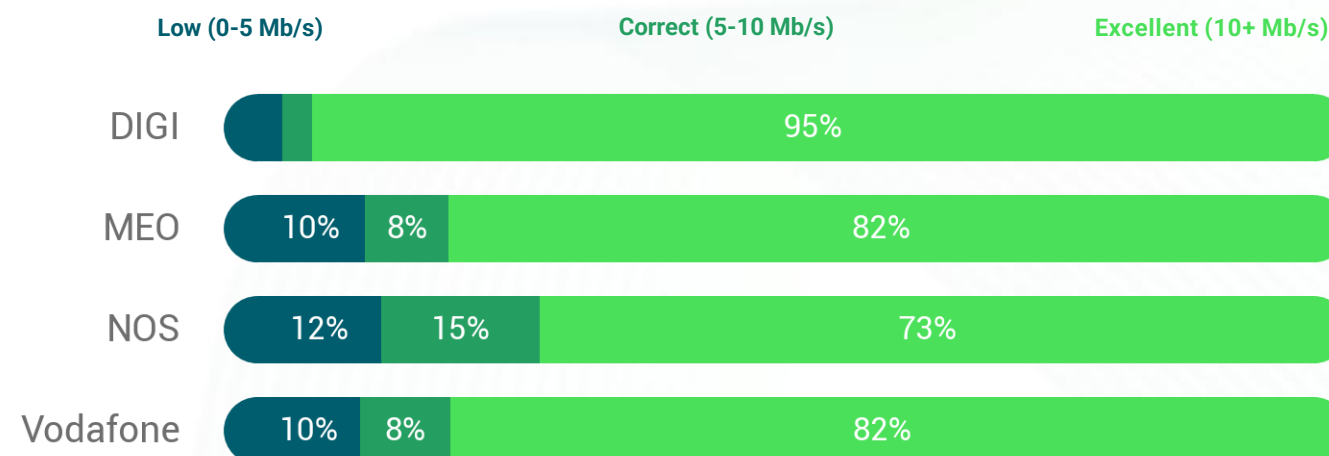

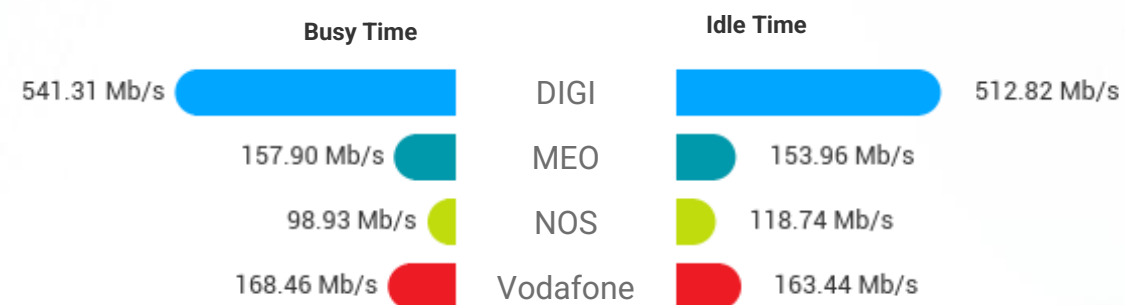

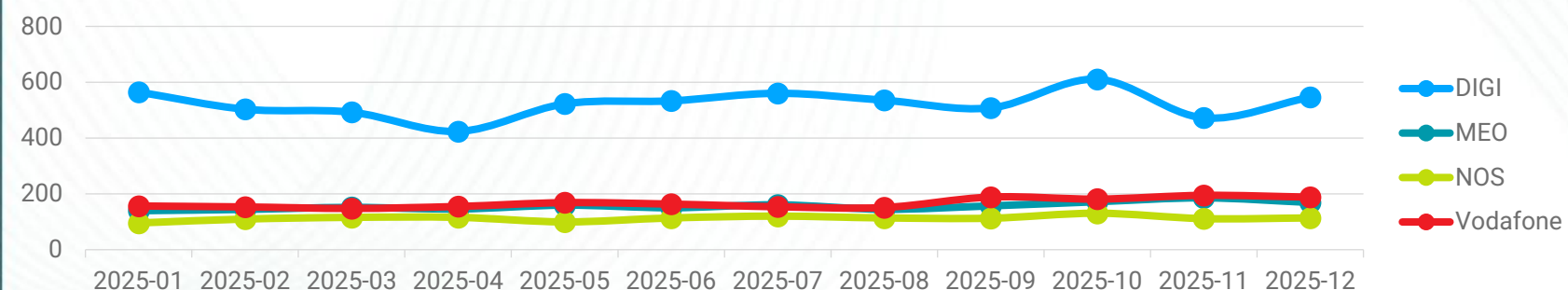

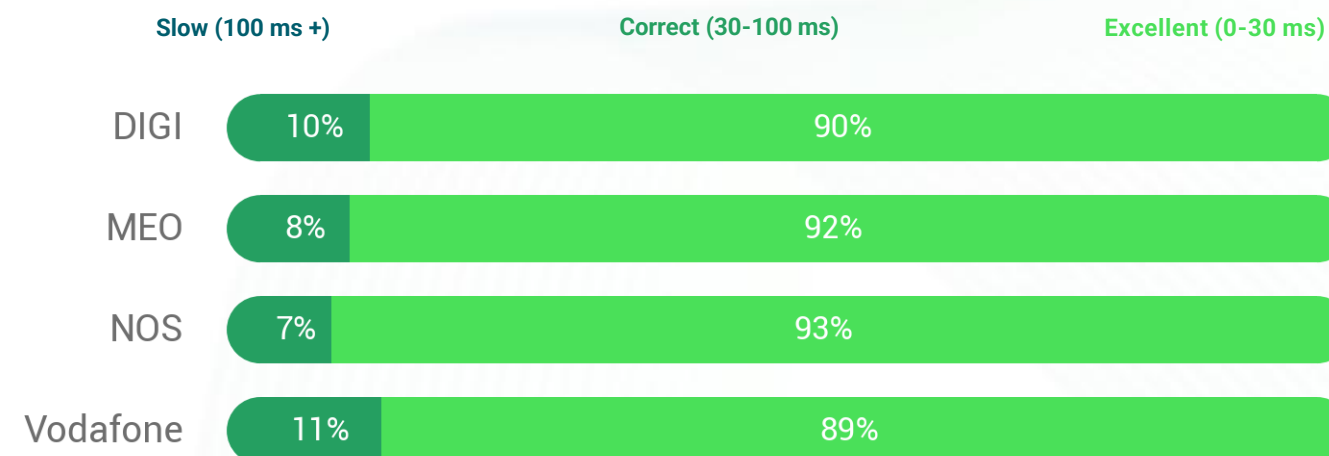

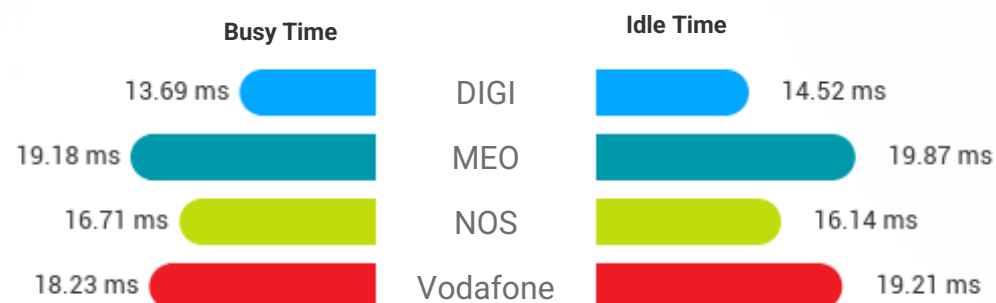

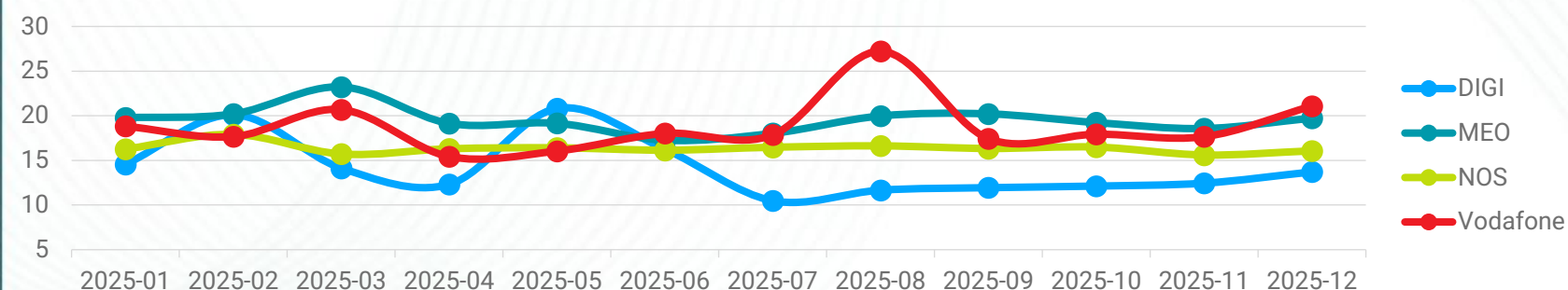

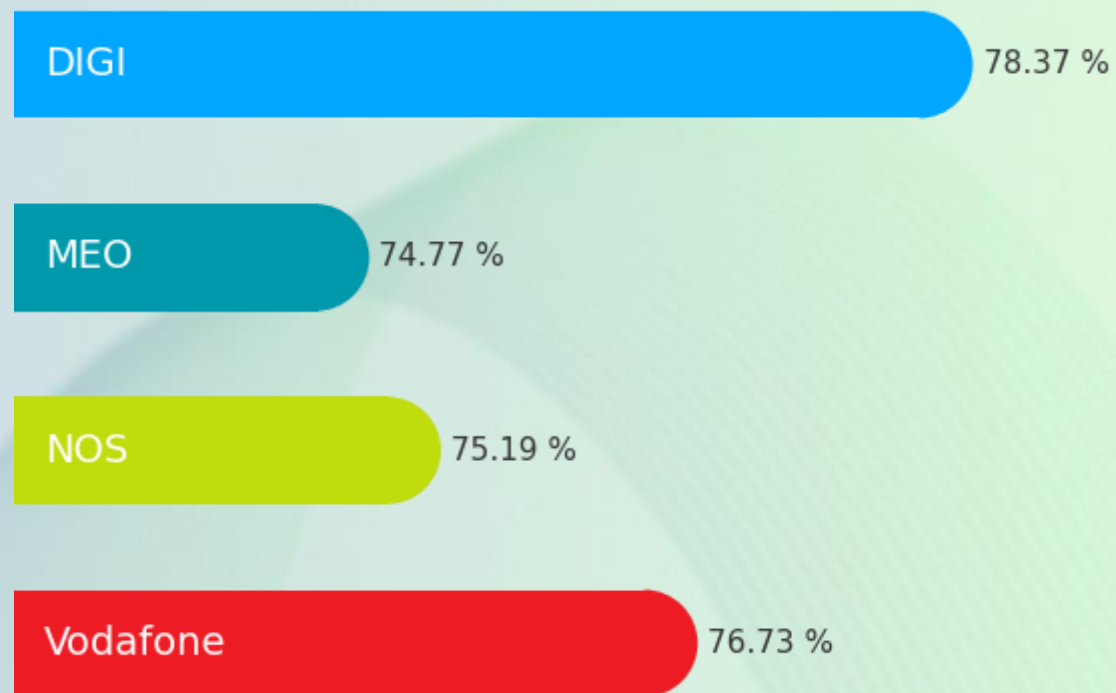
Latency evolution over the year (average)

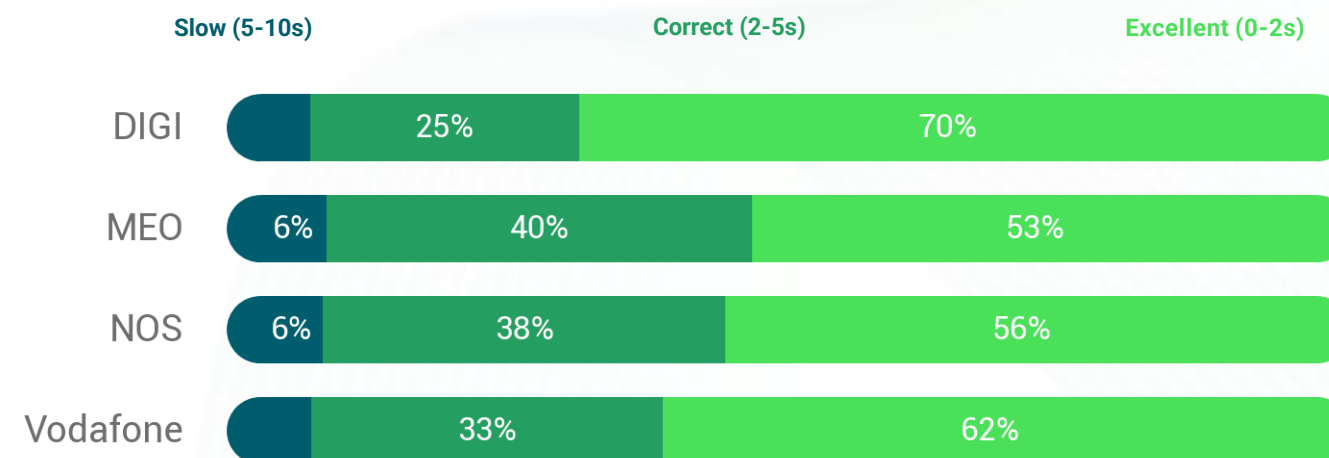

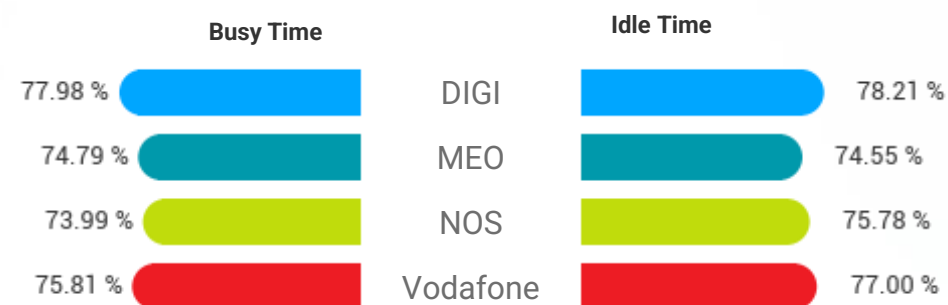

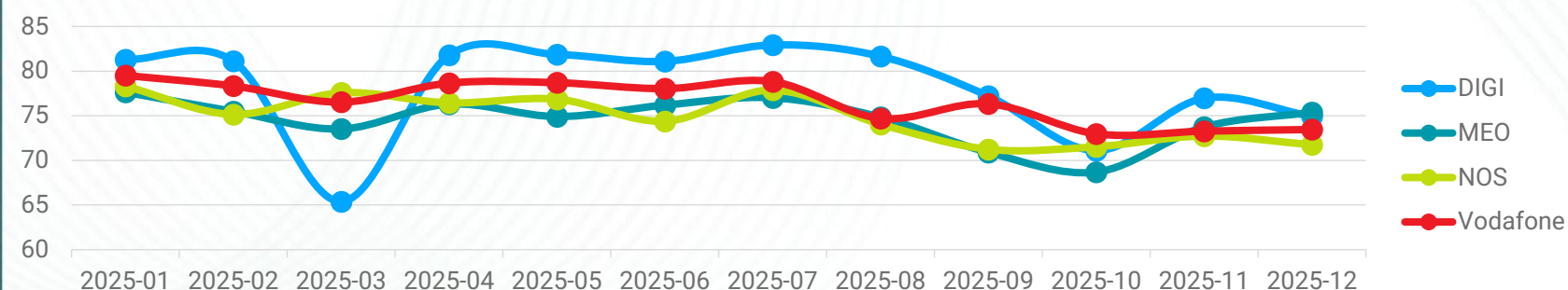

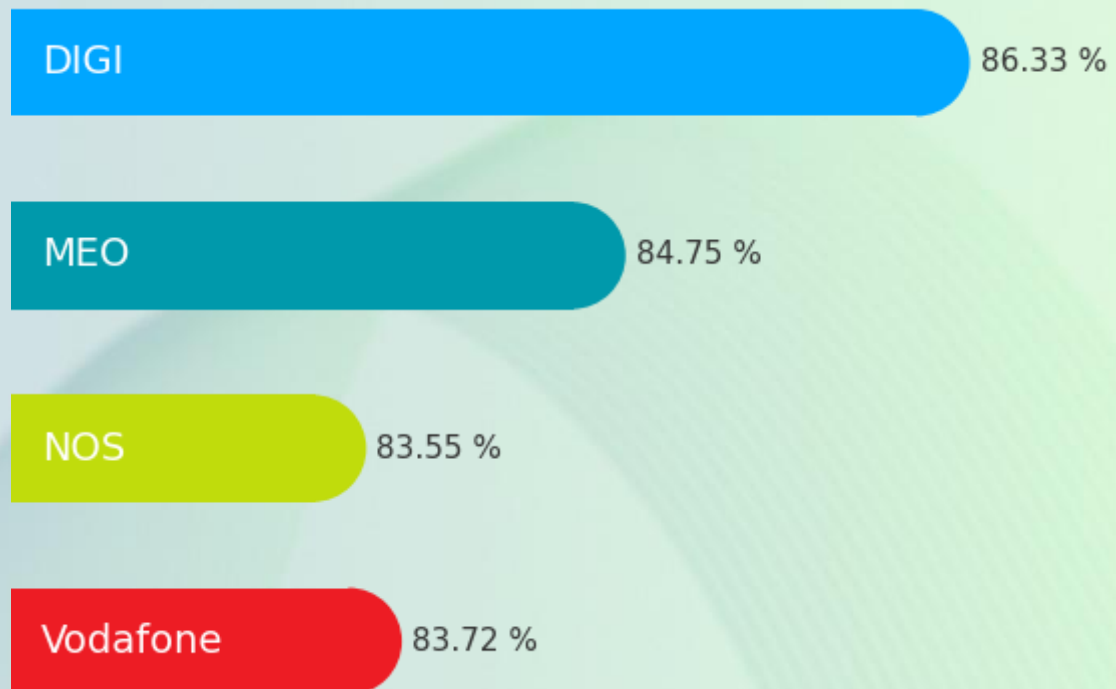

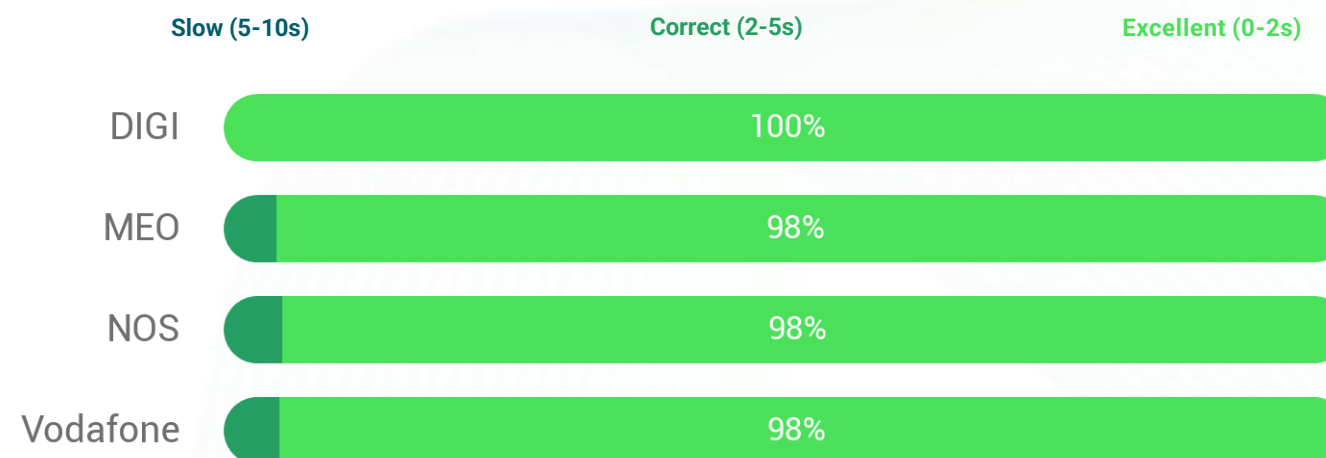

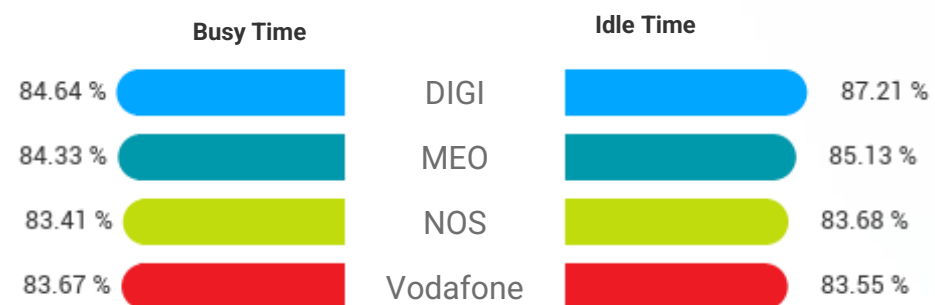

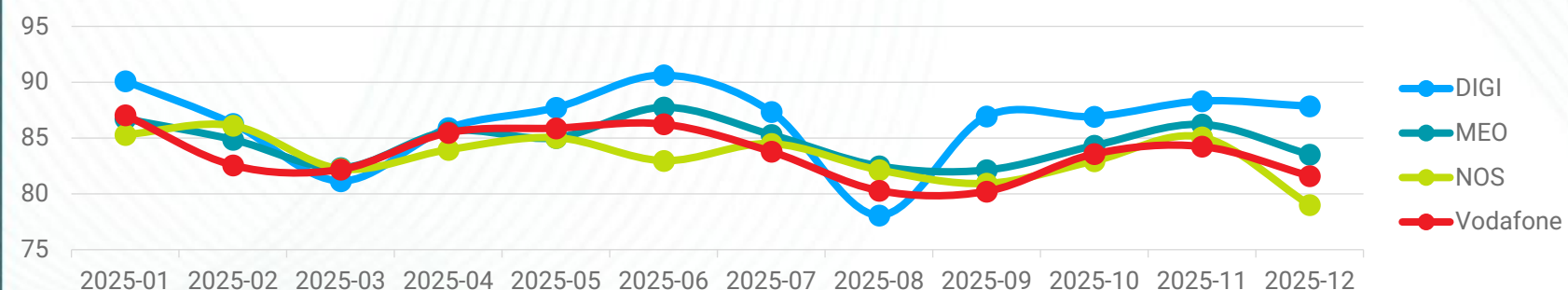

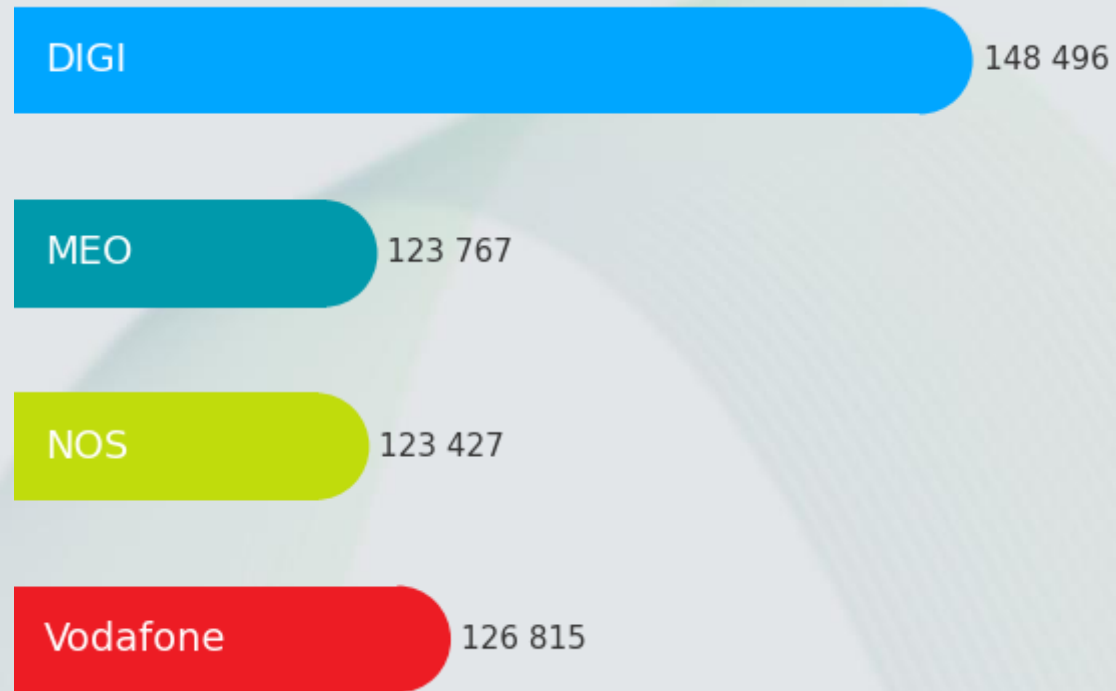

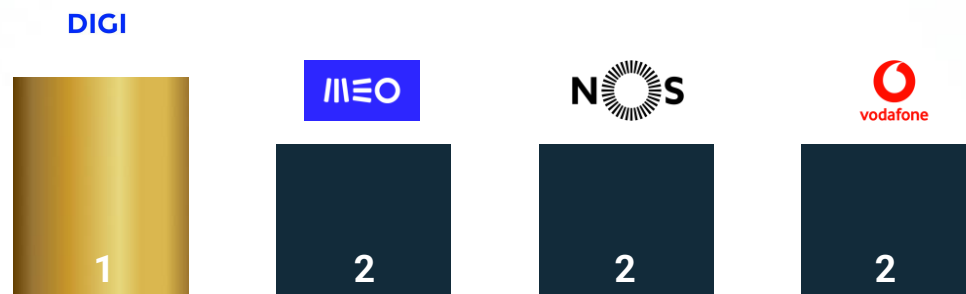

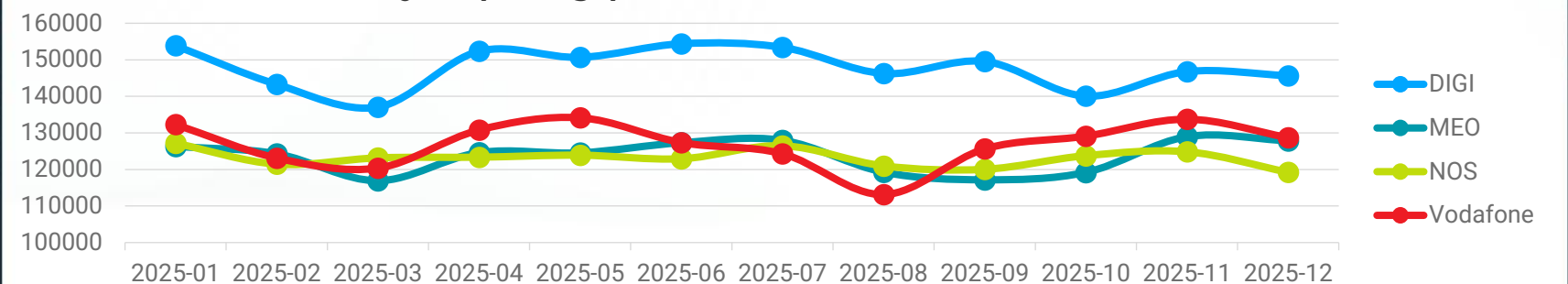

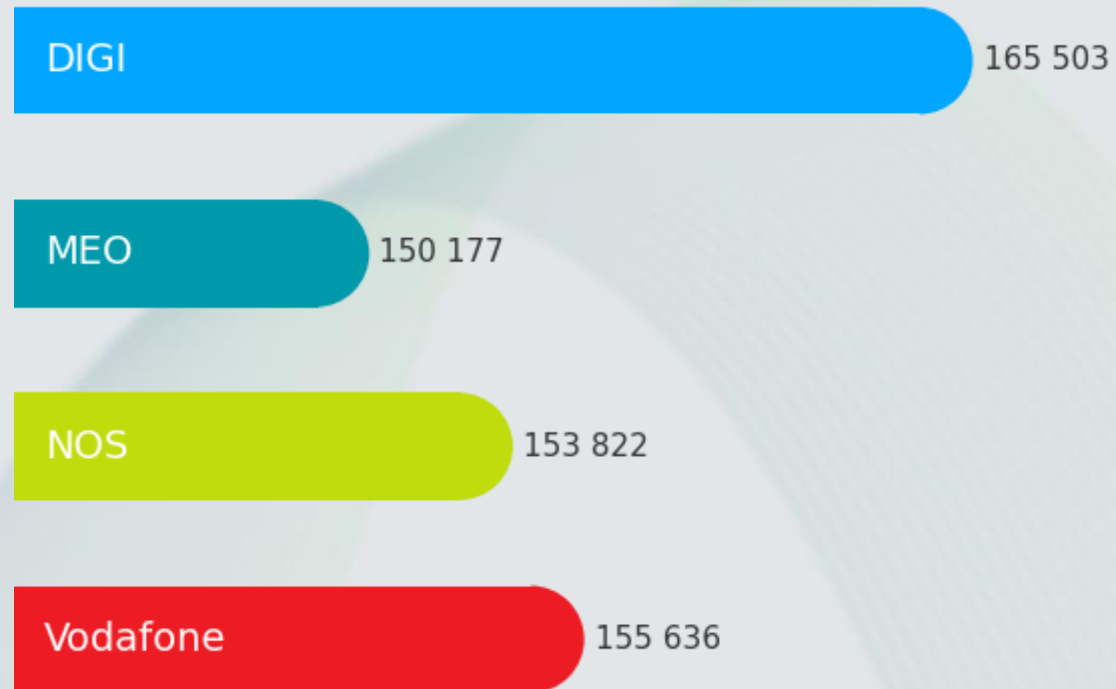

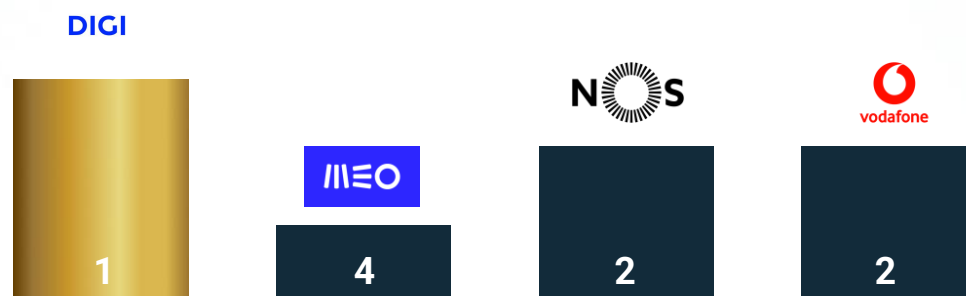

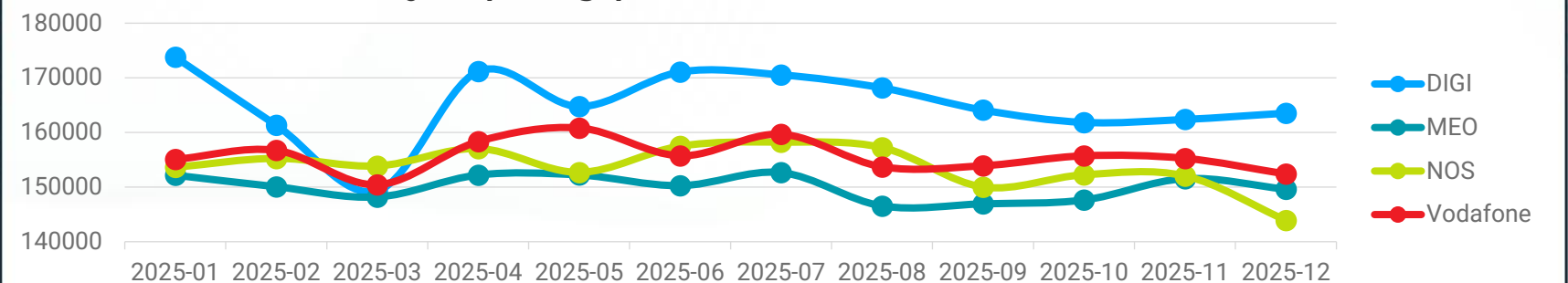

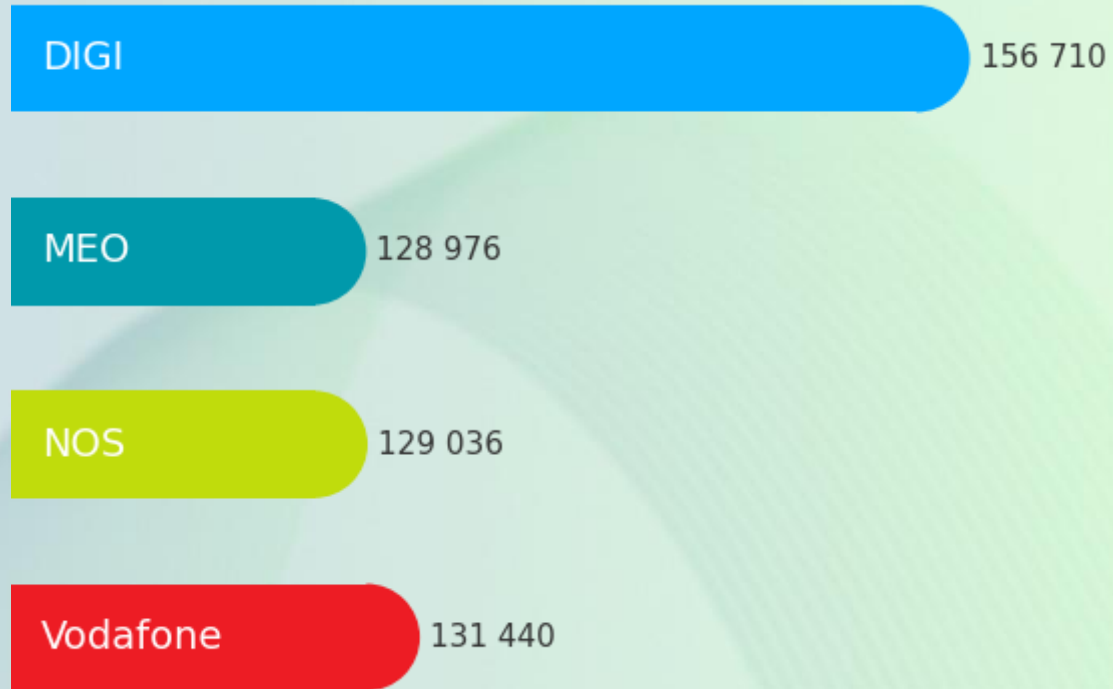
FTTH evolution over the year (average)

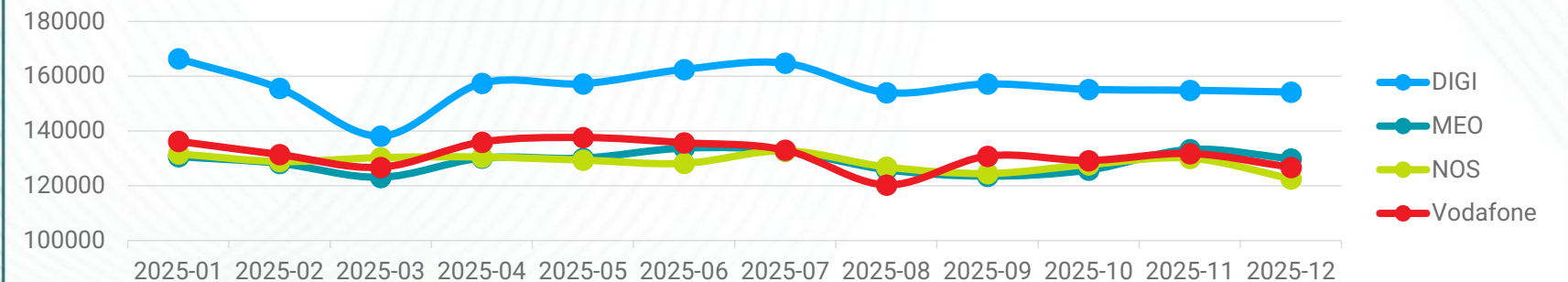
