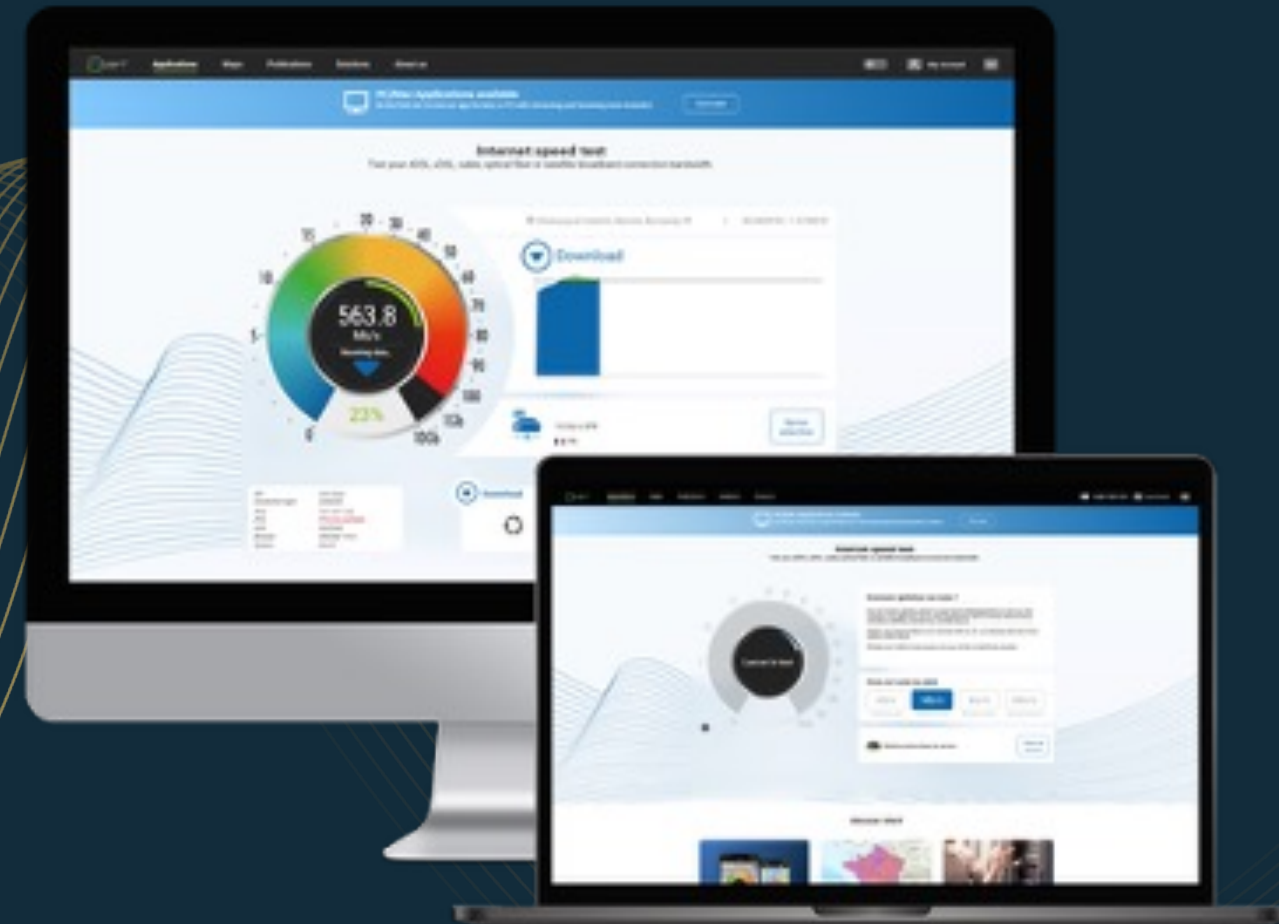

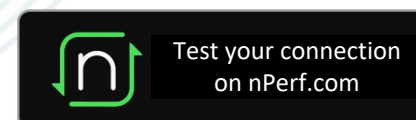

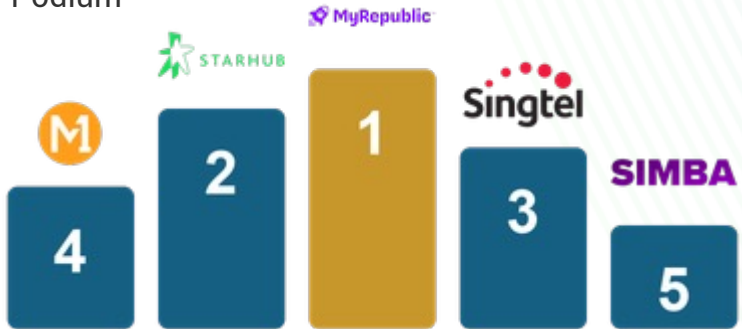

The best fixed-line Internet performances in Singapore for 2026 confirm a dynamic and increasingly competitive broadband sector. nPerf's latest barometer, covering the period from April 2025 to March 2026, reveals a clear hierarchy among the country's major ISPs, while highlighting meaningful progress across the board — particularly in download and upload speeds. MyRepublic consolidates its leadership position, StarHub makes a strong push on key metrics, and M1 delivers one of the most striking improvements of the cycle.

MyRepublic: Five Consecutive Years at the Top

MyRepublic has been a fixture at the summit of nPerf's Singapore fixed-line barometer, and this edition is no exception. Over five consecutive years, the operator has consistently led the overall rankings, maintaining dominance across Download speed (Mb/s), Upload speed (Mb/s), Web Browsing (%) and Youtube streaming (%). This year, MyRepublic records an overall score of 155,578, backed by best-in-class Download speed at 577.00 Mb/s and Upload speed at 467.82 Mb/s — up +20% on Upload compared to the previous period. On FTTH specifically, performance reaches an impressive 779.10 Mb/s download and 646.81 Mb/s upload, reinforcing its technical edge on fibre connections.

StarHub: Breaking New Ground in Latency and Streaming

StarHub climbs to second place overall with a score of 149,260, and this edition marks a notable milestone: the operator claims its first-ever top ranking in Latency (12.02 ms) and Youtube streaming (%) overall — a significant achievement in a sector where these metrics increasingly define the quality of the user experience. On WiFi, StarHub leads the overall ranking with a score of 152,576 and the best Latency at 8.99 ms, demonstrating strong infrastructure quality for home broadband users. The gap with MyRepublic continues to narrow, signalling a more contested competitive landscape than in previous years.

SingTel: Solid Network, Room to Climb

SingTel ranks third overall with a score of 138,176, supported by a Download speed of 422.22 Mb/s and Upload speed of 363.09 Mb/s. On FTTH, the operator posts 576.47 Mb/s download and 513.07 Mb/s upload, maintaining a respectable fibre footprint. However, Latency (19.27 ms overall) and Youtube streaming (%) remain areas where SingTel trails its main competitors. As Singapore's incumbent operator, it holds structural advantages in network reach and infrastructure investment that could translate into stronger barometer results in future editions.

M1: A Remarkable Upload Turnaround

M1 ranks fourth overall this period with a score of 126,900, but the headline story is its extraordinary Upload speed progression: a +1,081% improvement overall compared to the previous year — by far the most dramatic evolution recorded in this barometer cycle. This surge reflects a fundamental shift in M1's network capabilities, particularly on FTTH where Upload speed reaches 546.68 Mb/s. Combined with a five-year upward trend in overall score, M1 is clearly on a sustained growth trajectory. Download speed (356.89 Mb/s) and Web Browsing (%) still lag behind the top three, representing the primary levers for further improvement.

Simba: A Contender Building Its Base

Simba rounds out the ranking in fifth place overall with a score of 122,085, yet performs notably well on Latency (17.59 ms), placing second overall on that metric. On FTTH, Simba achieves 614.44 Mb/s download and 500.80 Mb/s upload — figures that compare favourably with larger operators. As a challenger operator, Simba's ability to deliver competitive speeds on fibre is an encouraging signal. To improve its overall positioning, the operator will need to strengthen Web Browsing (%) and Youtube streaming (%), where it currently trails more established players.

What to Watch in the Next Barometer

The Singapore fixed-line sector is entering a phase of heightened competition. MyRepublic will need to sustain its multi-year performance lead — particularly on Latency, where StarHub has now taken the top spot — to preserve its overall dominance. StarHub must confirm its newfound strengths in Latency and streaming as structural, not cyclical, gains. SingTel's priority should be closing the latency gap while leveraging its infrastructure scale. For M1, the Upload speed breakthrough must be accompanied by consistent progress in browsing and streaming quality to translate into a higher overall ranking. Meanwhile, Simba's trajectory on FTTH deserves close attention: if the operator can match its raw speed performance with a stronger quality-of-experience score, it could shake up the standings in the year ahead.

4. Methodology



nPerf provides a free application to assess Internet connection quality via its website and mobile apps (Android, iOS). Daily, thousands of people rely on nPerf for speed tests in their country, contributing to a comprehensive crowdsourced database covering all operators.

The study employs a strong filtering method to reflect real customer experiences on a specific network (mobile or fixed line). Measures are taken to prevent probes and measurement robots from affecting the results.

We assess:

▼ Download bitrate

Indicates the amount of data your connection can receive in one second from the nPerf server. The highest the measured value, the best is the bitrate of your connection.

▲ Upload bitrate

Indicates the amount of data your connection can send in one second to the nPerf server. The highest the measured value, the best is the bitrate of your connection.

◀▶ Latency (ping)

It indicated the delay a small packet of data requires to make a round-trip from your computer to the nPerf server. The shorter the delay, the most reactive your connection is. The mean is the minimum value.

🌐 Browsing performance

The browsing test assesses the load time of the fully loaded pages, including images, javascript, CSS, and fonts, for the five most popular sites. This indicator reflects the perceived quality by the user.

📺 Streaming performance

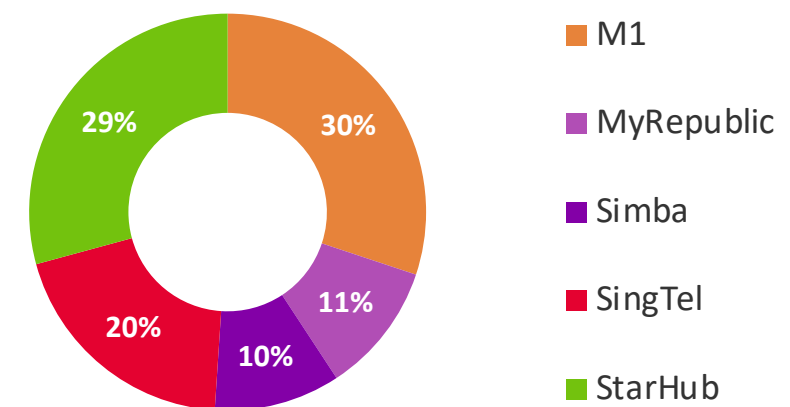
The video streaming test gauges the load time of a fully loaded video in three resolutions on YouTube, considering stalls during playback. This indicator reflects the perceived quality by the user.

Statistical precision is crucial in accurately determining winners. At nPerf, we prioritize test quality, precise reporting, and transparency. Analyzing a large volume of tests in this study, we've achieved 1.5% precision for absolute values and 1% point for percentage-based results, highlighting the reliability and accuracy of our data.

For a more comprehensive understanding of the user experience, our report takes into account test results during both Busy Hours (6 PM to 11 PM) and Idle Hours (the rest of the day). Busy Hours, marked by network strain, can impact user experience through congestion. This approach helps in understanding how network performance fluctuates throughout the day.

We only include national Internet service providers with test share above 5% share. The chart below shows the overall test distribution for each service provider.

Overall distribution of the tests per provider (ISPs Share)



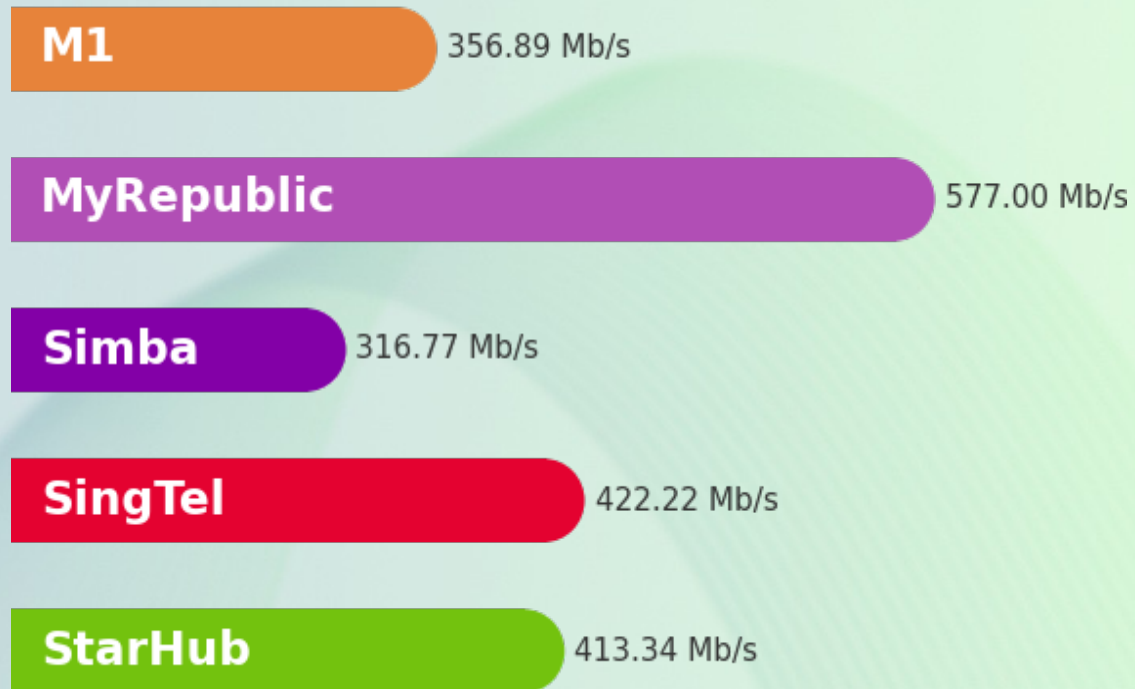

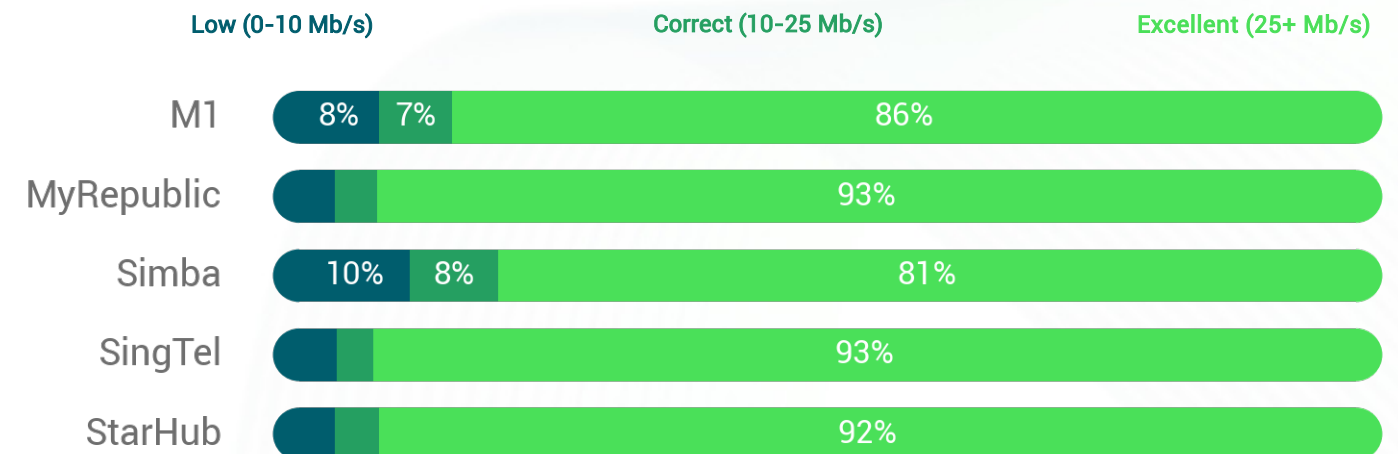

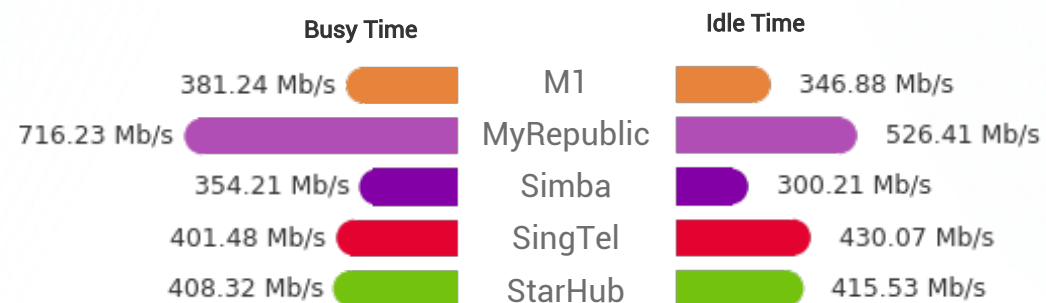

Download Speed results distribution (average)



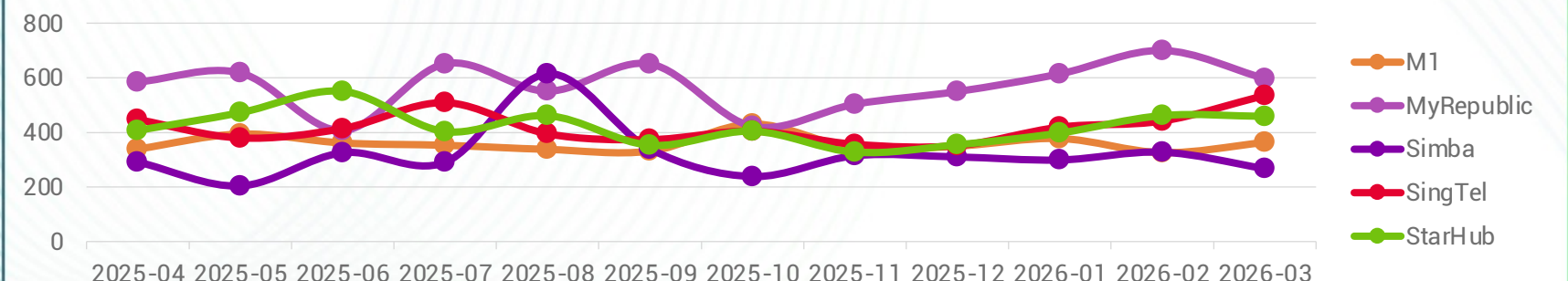

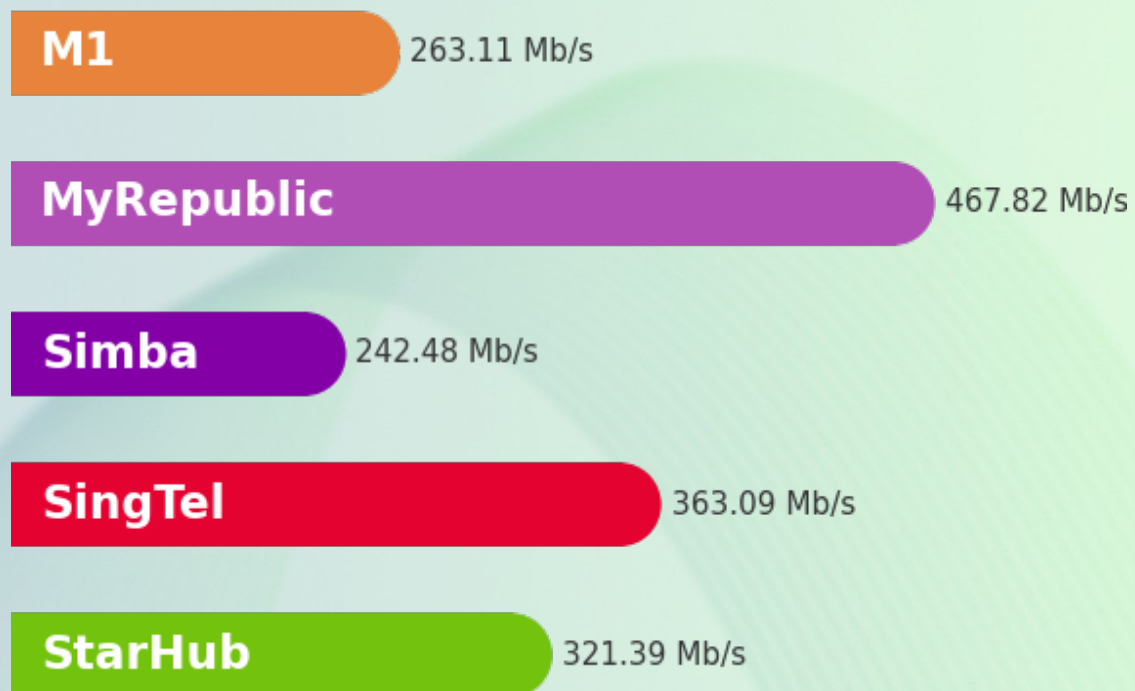

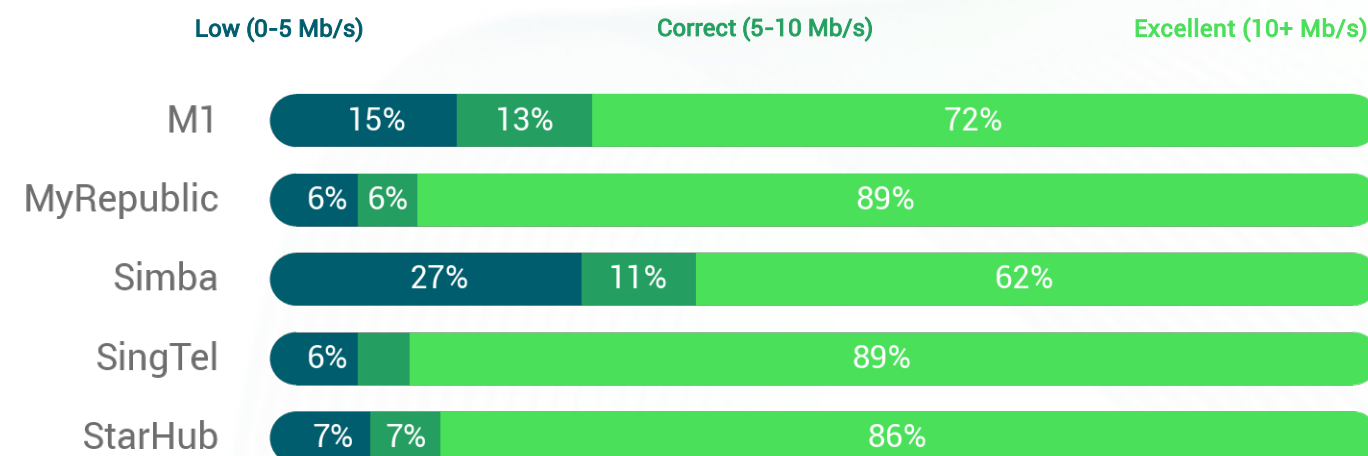

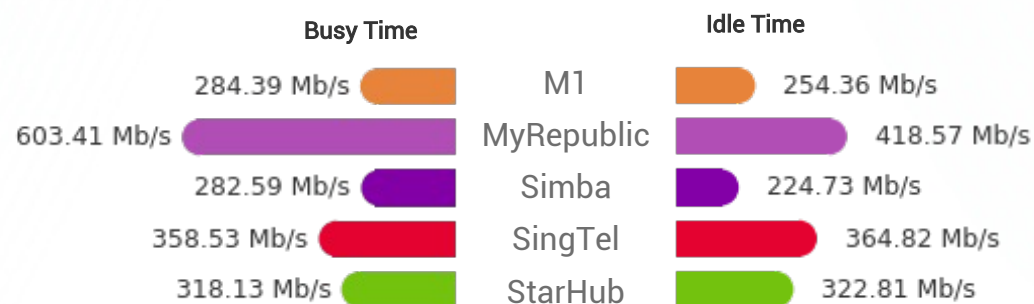

Upload Speed results distribution (average)



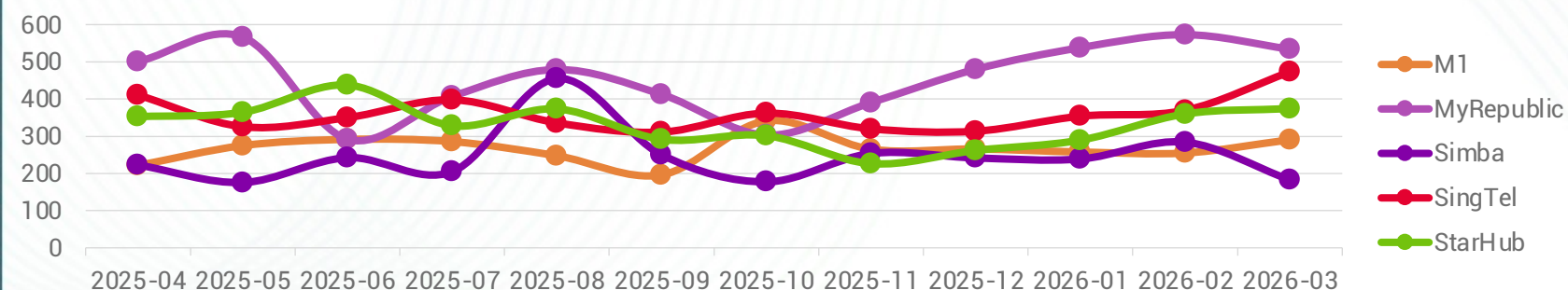

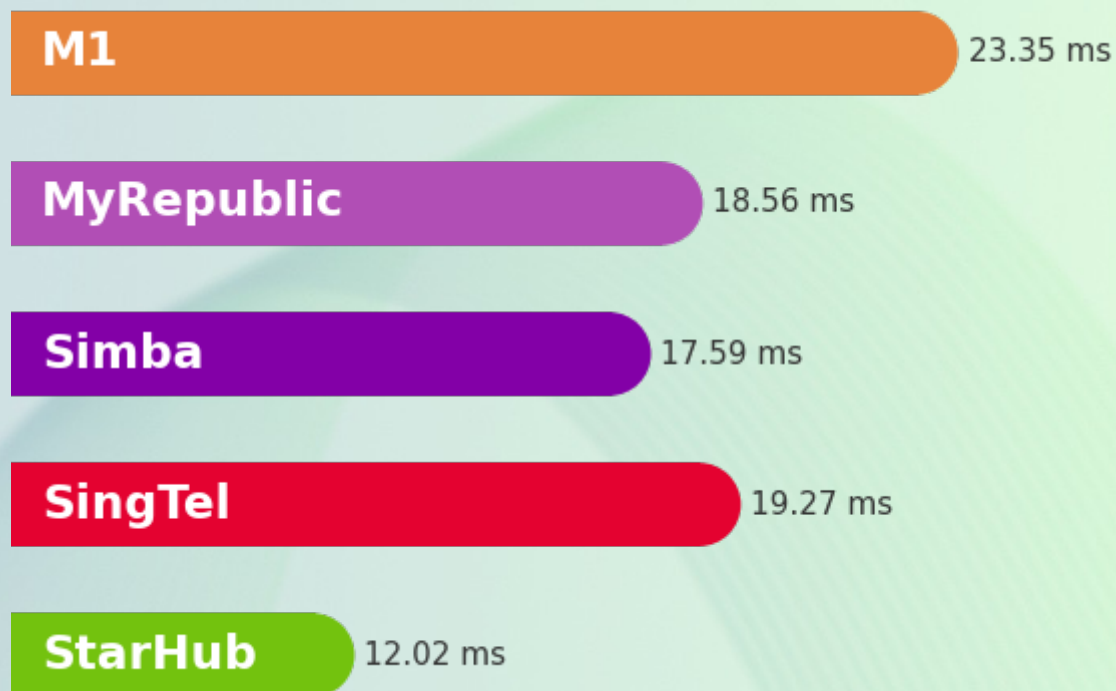
Upload Speed evolution over the year (average)

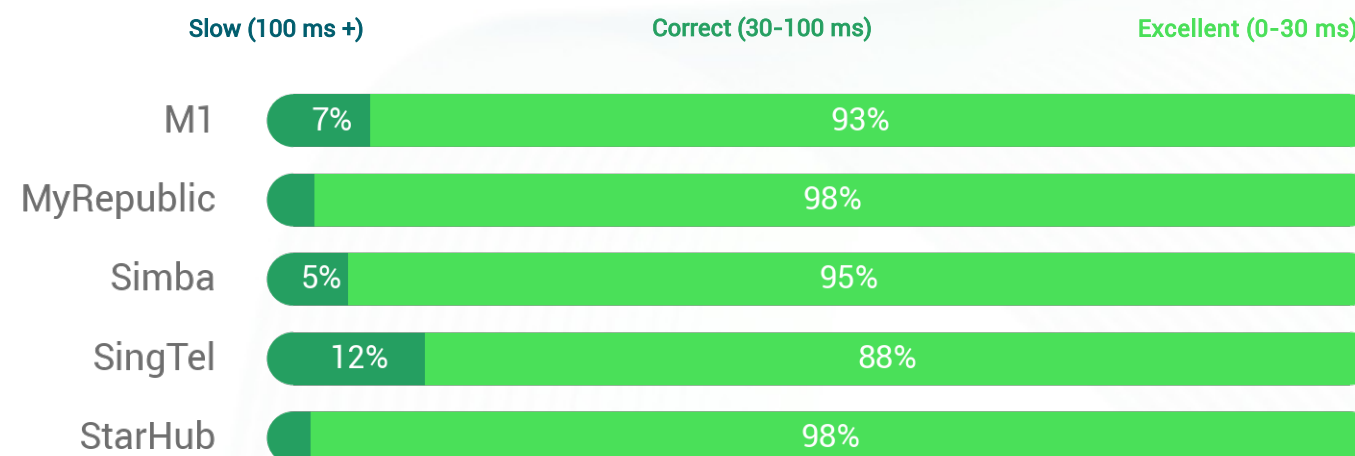

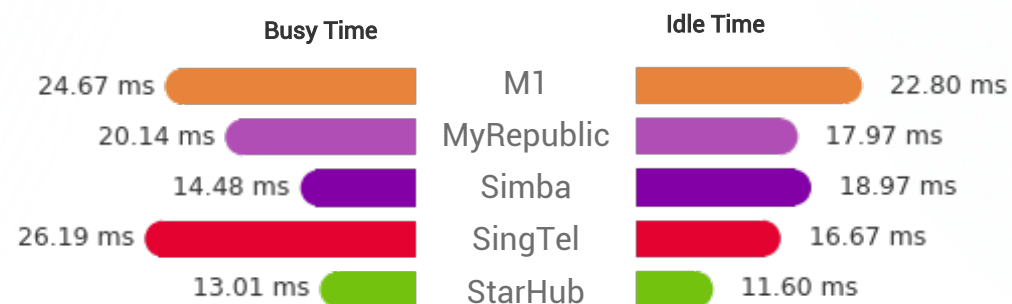

Latency results distribution (average)



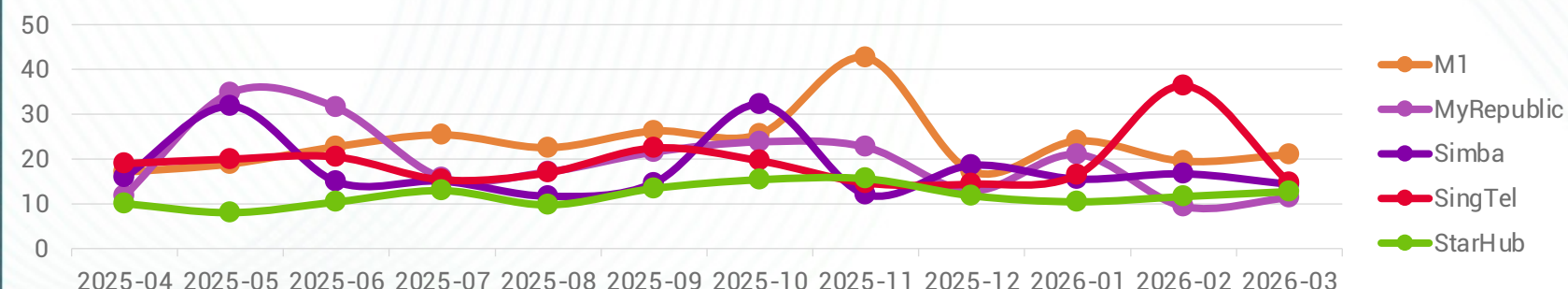

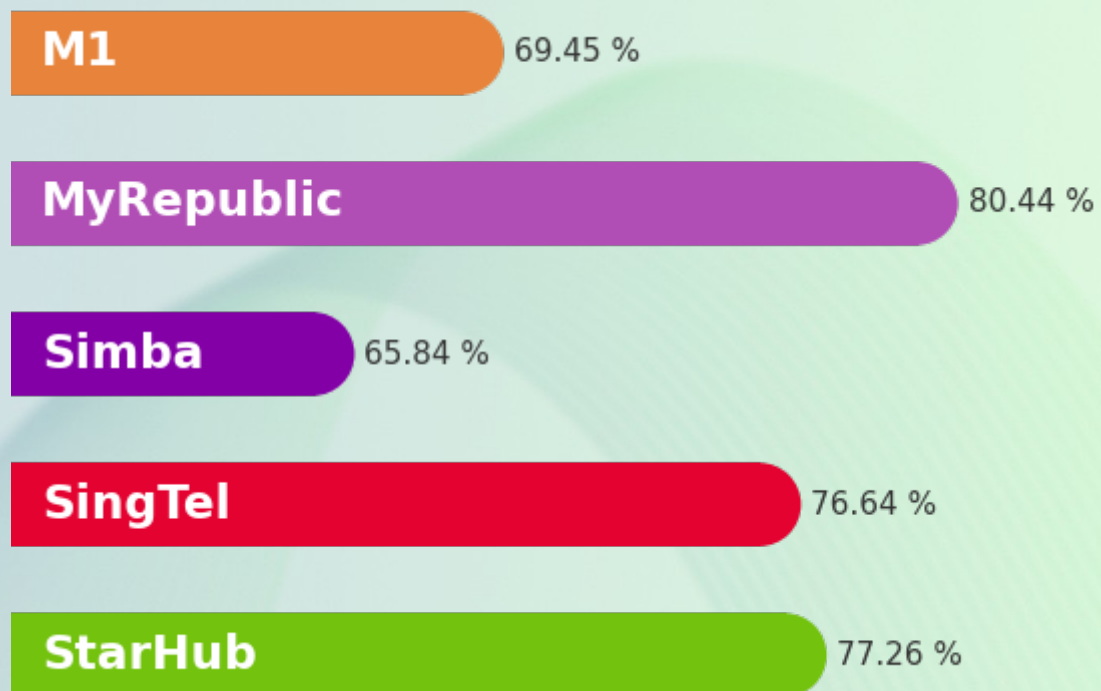
Latency evolution over the year (average)

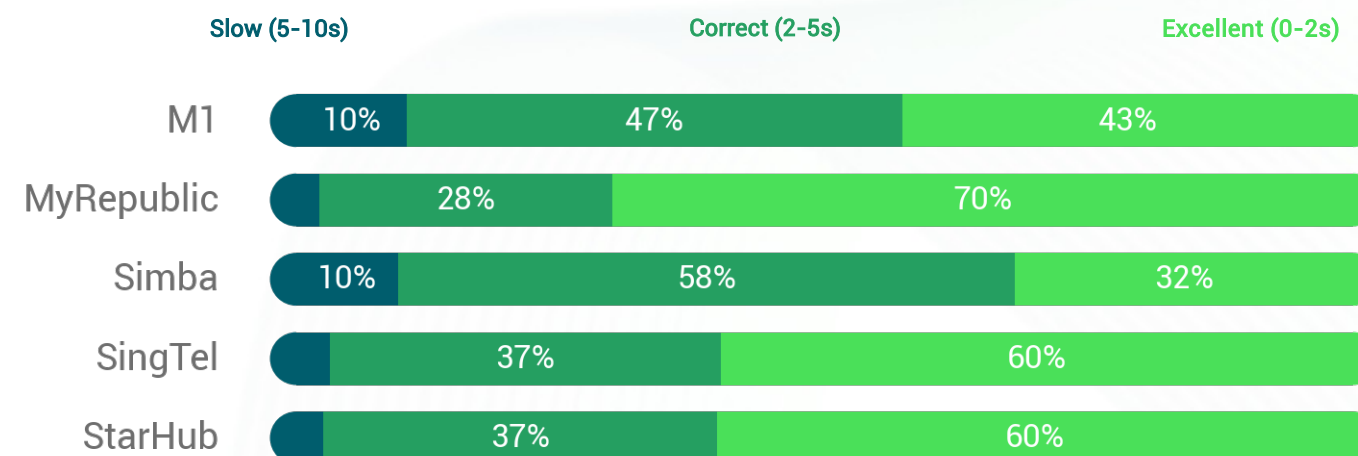

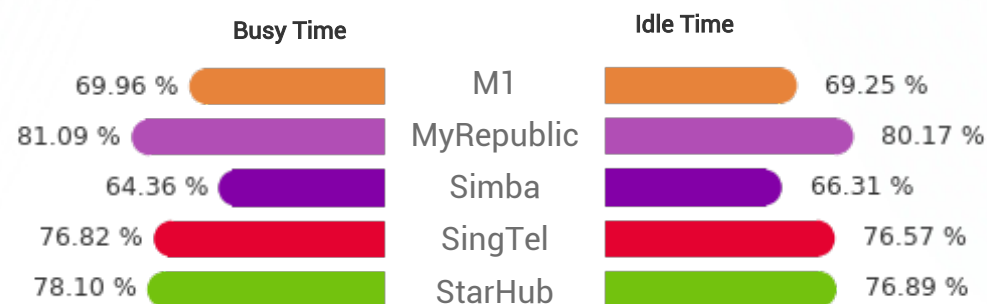

Browsing Performance results distribution (average)



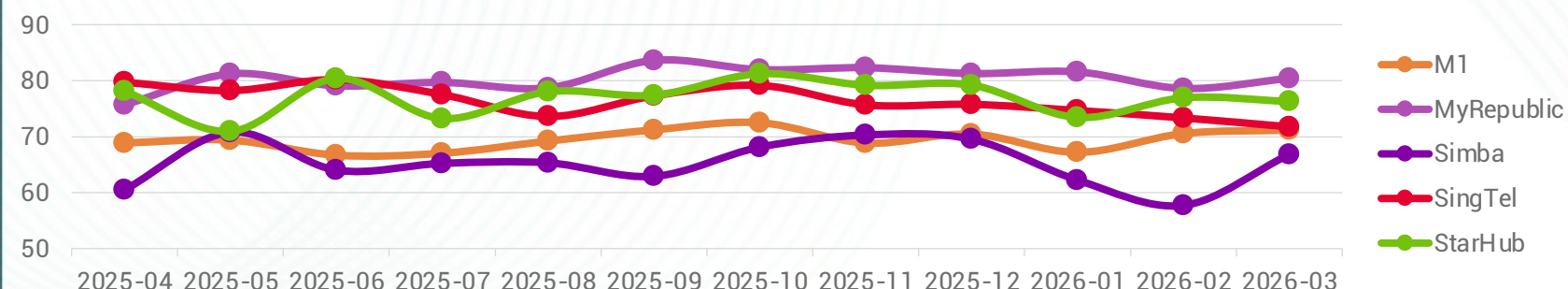

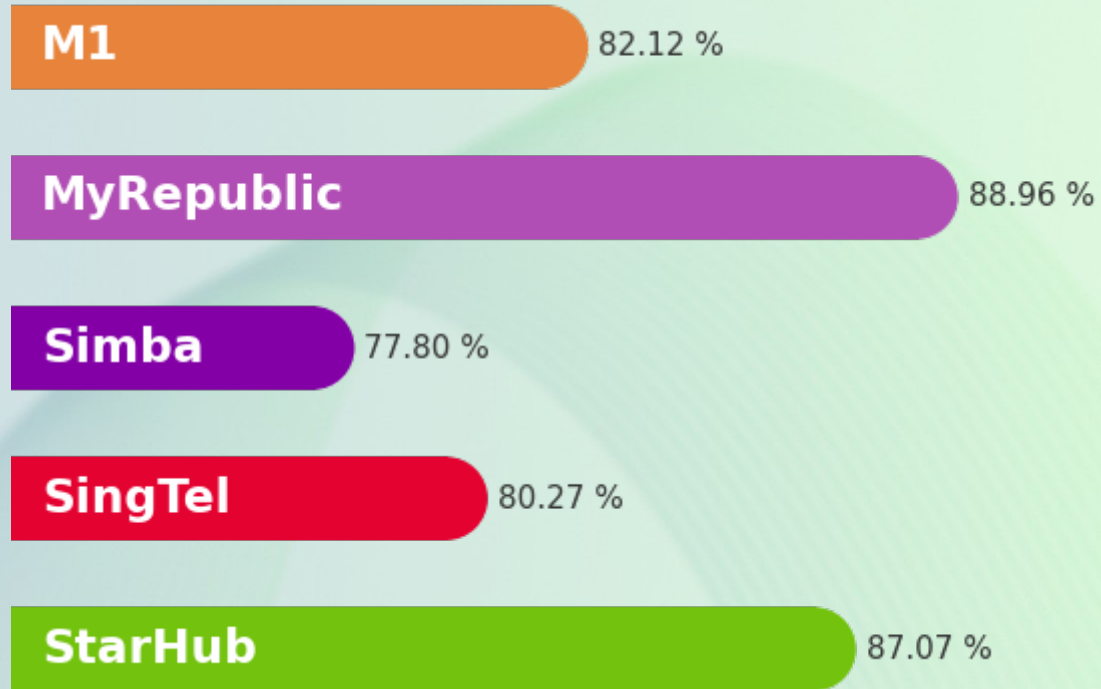

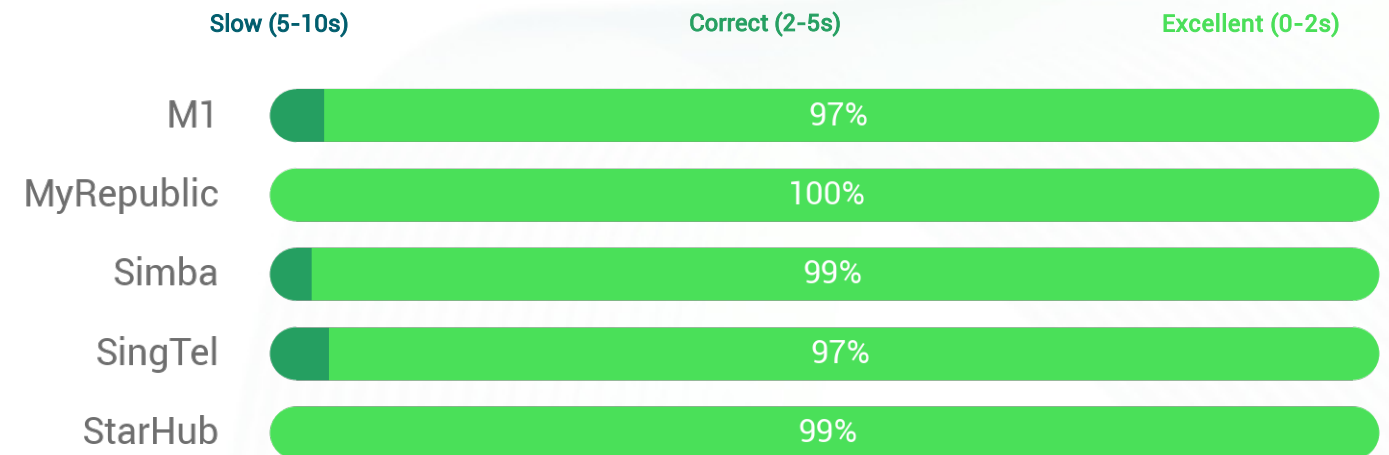

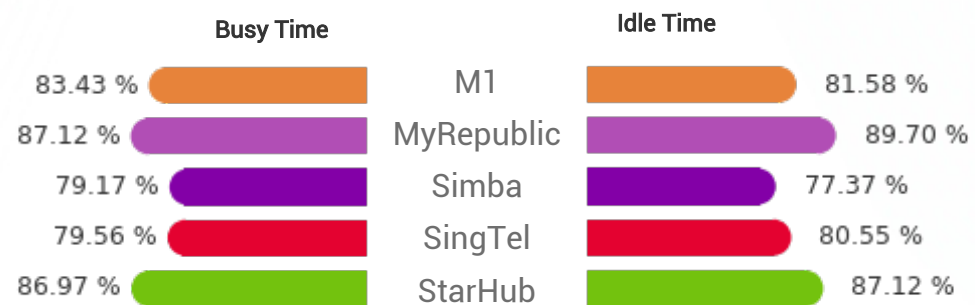

Streaming Performance results distribution (average)



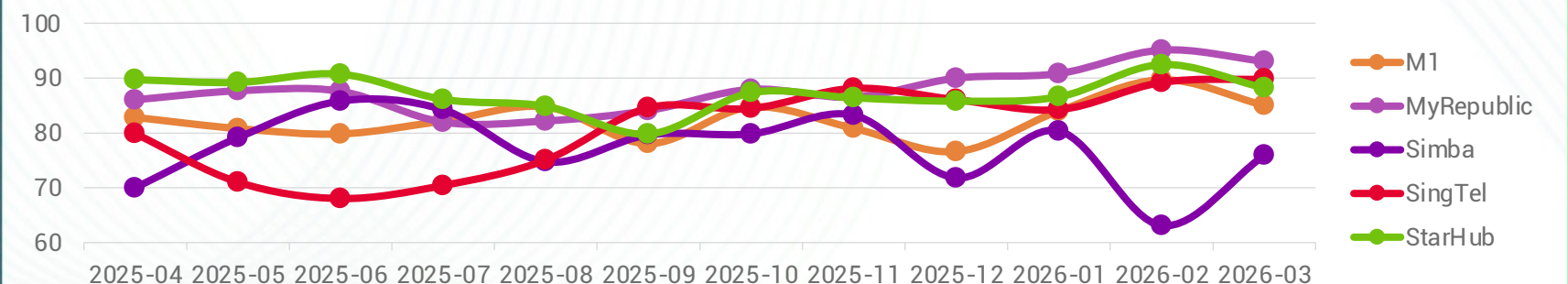

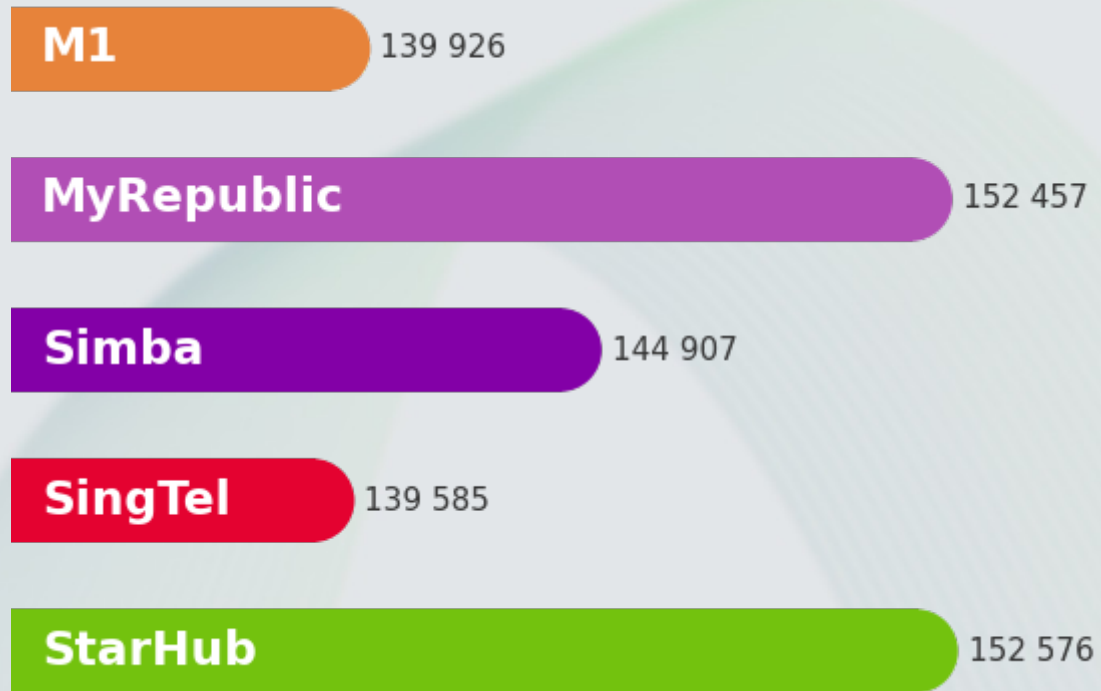

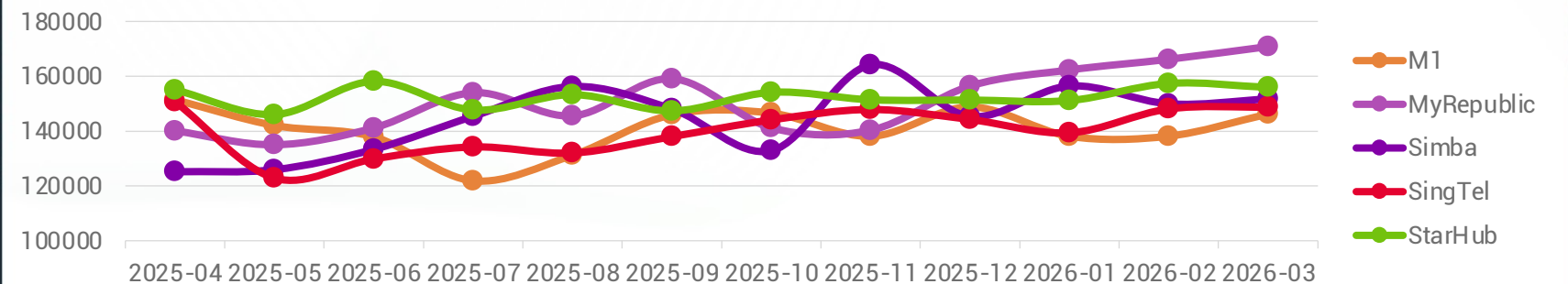

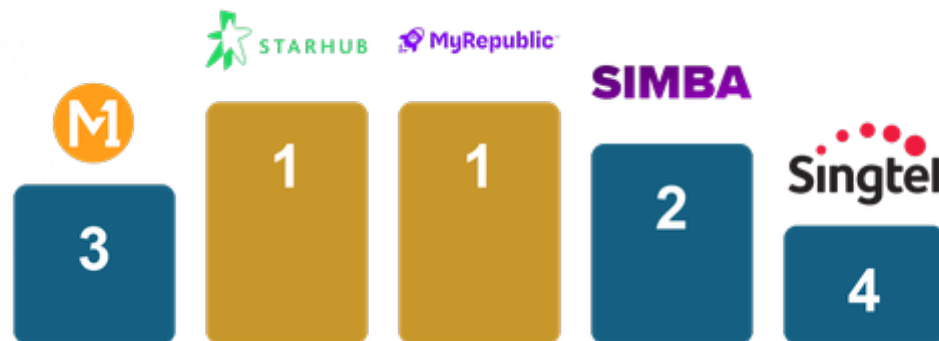

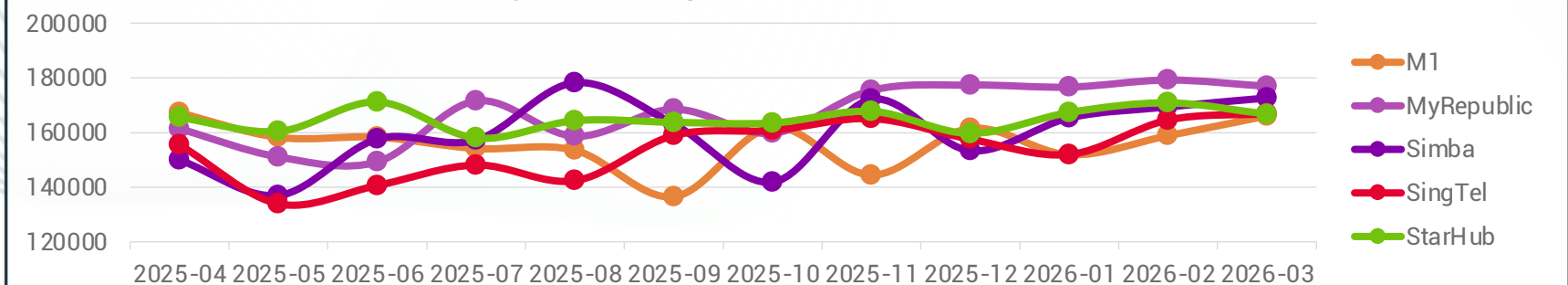

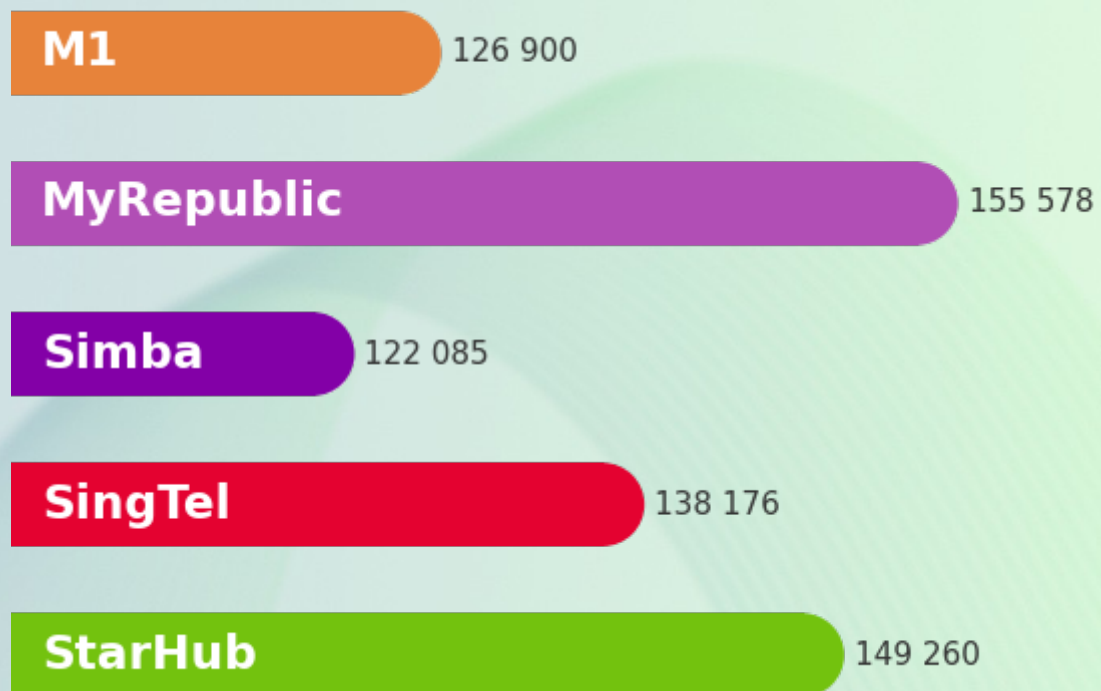
nPerf Score evolution over the year (average)

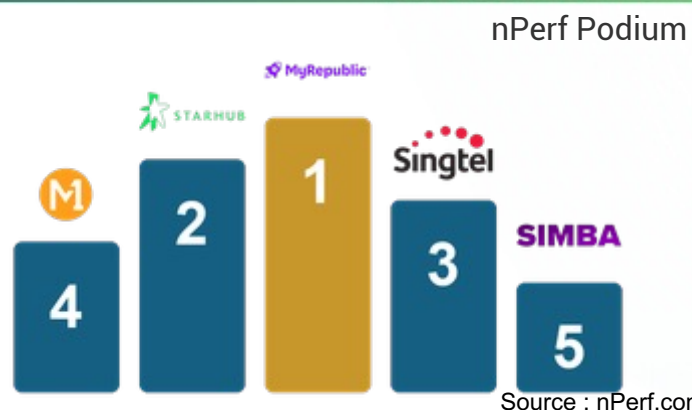

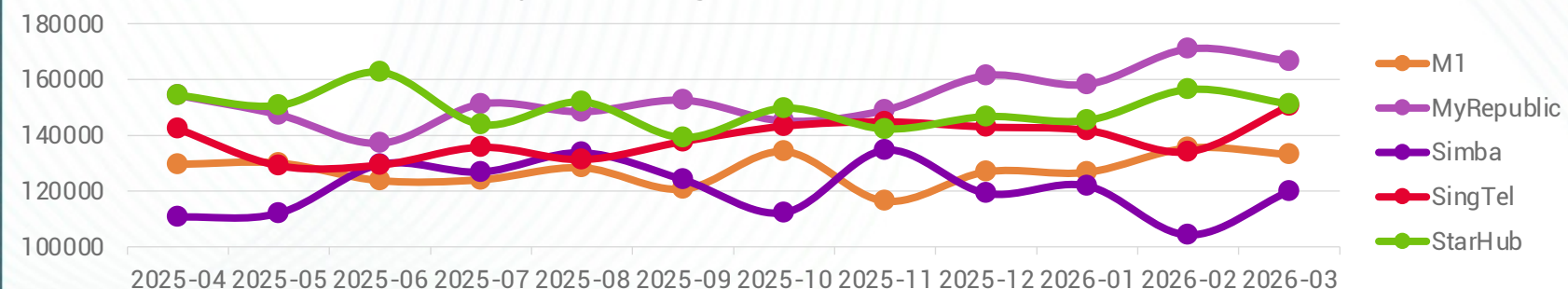


Best Fixed Internet performance in 2026
